本书由词汇和语法两部分构成。词汇部分主要汇集了《大学英语》、《核心英语》两套全国统编教材中符合大纲要求的常用词汇。大部分单词、词组和短语配有精选的例句。重点词汇还设置同义词辨析。所有例句力求规范、精炼和通俗易懂,以便于学生记忆和理解,同时配有专项练习供及时巩固所学词汇用。语法部分旨在完成中学英语向大学英语的过渡和延伸,因此,该部分并非面面俱到,而是突出针对性、实用性,并配有专项例解和练习,以便使学生更好地理解和应用所学语法知识。

absorb /əb'sɔ:b/ *vt.* ① 吸收: Dry sand absorbs water. ② 吸引…的注意力;使全神贯注: She is completely absorbed in her business.

> absorbent *a.* 能吸收的 absorption *n.* 吸收;专注

accomplish /ə'kʌmplɪʃ/ *vt.* 完成;实现(同义 achieve, complete 反义 undo): They tried to arrange a peace, but accomplished nothing.

> accomplished *a.* 熟练的;技巧的 accomplishment *n.* 完成;成就

achieve /ə'tʃi:v/ *vt.* ① 完成;实现(同义 accomplish 反义 fail): By hard work we can achieve anything. ② 达到;得到: He wants to achieve his purpose.

> achievement *n.* 完成;成就

辨析: achieve, accomplish, complete 和 finish 皆有“完成”之意。其中 complete 和 finish 仅表“完成、结束”: The building is not completed yet. Have you finished your school paper? achieve 和 accomplish 则表示“通过努力而获得成功、成就或达到…”: Our team is trying to do everything possible to accomplish its aims.

adapt /ə'dæpt/ *vt.* ① 使适应;使适合(同义 adjust 反义 unfit): You must adapt yourself to new manners and customs. ② 改编;改写: This book is adapted for beginners. *vi.* (to) 适应: He has not yet adapted to the climate.

> adaptable *a.* 能适应的;可改编的 adaptation *n.* 适应;改编

adjust /ə'dʒʌst/ *vt.* ① 调节;改变…以适应(同义 adapt): The body

adjusts itself to changes in temperature. ② 校正;调整(同义 regulate); Please don't adjust my TV set.

> adjustable *a.* 可调整的 adjustment *n.* 调节;调整

affect /ə'fekt/ *vt.* ① 影响(同义 influence); The climate affected his health. ② (在感情方面)打动; Her death affected us deeply

> affecting *a.* 感人的 affection *n.* 慈爱;友爱

辨析: affect 和 effect 字形相近,易用混。affect 作动词时意为“影响”: Some plants are quickly affected by cold. effect 作动词时指蓄意行为所产生的预期效果: The recent development of events effected a change in my opinion.

afford /ə'fɔ:d/ *vt.* ① 买得起;担负得起: At last we can afford a house! ② 提供;给予: It will afford me great pleasure to have dinner with you.

alarm /ə'lɑ:m/ *v.* ① 使惊恐: Everybody was alarmed at the bad news. ② 向…报警: The noise of the shot alarmed hundreds of birds. *n.* ① 惊恐;忧虑: He jumped up in a alarm. ② 报警(器): It turned out that it's a false alarm.

> alarming *a.* 惊人的

amaze /ə'meiz/ *vt.* 使大为惊奇;使惊愕(同义 astonish): You amaze me!

> amazing *a.* 令人惊奇的 amazement *n.* 惊奇;吃惊

辨析: 见 astonish (P. 113)

analyze /'ænaləiz/ *vt.* 分析;分解: Well, let's analyze the sentence.

< analysis *n.* 分析;分解

apply /ə'plai/ *vi.* ① 申请;请求: You may apply to the Consul for a visa. ② 适用: The rule does not apply to all cases. *vt.* 应用;运用: We should apply a theory to practice.

> applied *a.* 应用的; 实用的 application *n.* 申请; 应用

approach /ə'prəʊtʃ/ *v.* 靠近; 接近: As winter approached, weather became colder. *n.* ① 接近: The boy ran away at my approach. ② 途径: This book provides a good approach to electronics. ③ 方式; 方法: I don't think it is a correct approach to the subject.

argue /'ɑ:gju:/ *vi.* 争论; 争辩: Don't argue with me. *vt.* ① 论证; 主张: He argued that the experiment could be done in another way. ② 说服: They tried to argue her into joining them.

> argument *n.* 争论; 争吵

argue sb. into (out of) doing sth. 说服某人做或不做某事

arise /ə'raɪz/ *vi.* ① 出现; 发生: A new difficulty has arisen. ② (from) 由...引起; 起源于: Development arises from the contradictions inside a thing.

辨析: arise, rise 和 raise 三词极易混淆。arise 是不及物动词, 表示“发生”或“出现”: Before they could start, a mist arose. rise 也是不及物动词, 表示“上升, 升起”: The moon has not risen yet. raise 是及物动词, 表示“举起”等: The old lady can't raise such a heavy bag.

arrange /ə'reɪndʒ/ *vt.* ① 安排; 筹划: Before leaving he arranged his business affairs. ② 整理; 排列; 布置: I arranged the books on the shelves.

> arrangement *n.* 安排; 布置

arrest /ə'rest/ *vt.* 逮捕; 拘留: The police arrested the thief. *n.* 逮捕; 拘留: The officer was put under arrest.

> arresting *a.* 显著的; 引人注目的

assign /ə'saɪn/ *vt.* ① (to) 指派; 选派: Two girls were assigned to sweep the classroom. ② 分配; 布置(作业): Those rooms are as-

signed to us. ③ 指定(时间、地点等): Has a day been assigned for the trip?

> assignable *a.* 可分派的 assignment *n.* 分配;分派;作业

associate /ə'səʊʃieɪt/ *vt.* 把...联系在一起;使结合在一起: We associate Egypt with the Nile. *vi.* (with) 交往: Don't associate with dishonest boys. *n.* 伙伴;合伙人: He has no associates. *a.* 副的: He is an associate professor.

> association *n.* 联合;协会

attach /ə'tætʃ/ *vt.* ① 系;贴;连接(同义 connect 反义 detach): You should attach labels to the luggage. ② 使成为一部分;使附属: My aunt has a house with a garage attached. ③ 使依恋: She is deeply attached to her young brother.

> attachment *n.* 附属;深情

attempt /ə'tempt/ *vt. /n.* 企图;试图(同义 try): Don't attempt impossibilities.

辨析: attempt 和 try 皆有“试图、尝试”之意,有时可互换,但 try 一般无褒贬之分: I don't think I can do it, but I'll try. attempt 有时含贬意,表示“企图”: He attempted to escape, but failed.

attract /ə'trækt/ *vt.* 吸引;引起...的注意(同义 draw): Bright colours attract babies.

> attractive *a.* 有吸引力的;动人的 attraction *n.* 吸引力

average /'ævərɪdʒ/ *v.* 平均: The rainfall averages thirty-seven inches a year. *a.* ① 平均的: What is the average temperature here? ② 平常的;普通的: Most of us are of average ability. *n.* 平均数;平均: The average of four, five and nine is six.

|| on an (the) average 平均而言;通常

avoid /ə'void/ *vt.* 避免;避开: We only just avoided an accident.

> avoidable *a.* 可避免的

behave /bi'heiv/ *vi.* ① 表现;举止(同义 *act*): The boy behaves bravely. ② (机器等)运转: How is your new car behaving?

vt. 检点(自己的)行为: Behave yourself.

> behaviour *n.* 行为;举止

blast /blɑ:st/ *vt.* 炸;炸掉: Danger! Blasting in progress! *n.* ① 爆炸: Thousands of windows are broken by blast. ② 一阵(疾风等);一股(强烈的气流): A blast of hot air came from the furnace.

broadcast /'brɔ:dkɑ:st/ *v. /n.* 广播;播音: She is broadcasting the news.

> broadcasting *n. /a.* 广播(的)

capture /'kæptʃə/ *vt. /n.* 捕获;俘获: The police have not captured the thief yet.

celebrate /'selibreit/ *v.* 庆祝: They celebrated his birthday.

> celebrated *a.* 著名的 celebration *n.* 庆祝;庆典

辨析: celebrate 和 congratulate 都可表示“庆贺”,但 celebrate 只用于对事件的庆祝,如生日、节日、纪念日等: They celebrated their wedding anniversary last week. congratulate 则用于对人的祝贺: He congratulated me on my marriage.

challenge /'tʃælindʒ/ *vt.* 向...挑战: He challenged me to try again. *n.* 挑战: He accepted the challenge.

charge /tʃɑ:dʒ/ *vt.* ① 索价;要...支付: How much do you charge for mending a pair of shoes? ② 控告;指控(同义 *accuse*): He was charged with murder. ③ 充电: He asked me to charge the battery. *n.* ① 价钱;费用: Your charges are too high. ② 控告;指控: What is the charge against him? ③ 充电;电荷: This is a positive charge.

chase /tʃeɪs/ *vt. /n.* 追逐; 追赶: Chase that dog out of the garden.

cheat /tʃi:t/ *vt.* 欺骗; 骗取(同义 deceive): He cheated her of her money. *vi.* 行骗; 作弊: John cheated in the examination.

辨析: cheat 和 deceive 同义, 但 cheat 是普通用语, 指用不诚实手段取得所需或达到目的, 也指经商中的欺骗: He would never cheat me. deceive 多指以某种手段使人相信虚假的事情来隐瞒真相: He deceived the teacher by lying.

chew /tʃu:/ *v.* 咀嚼: Chew your food well before you swallow it.

|| chew sth. over / chew on sth. 考虑...

chill /tʃɪl/ *vt.* 使变冷; 使冷冻; 使感到冷: He was chilled to the bone. *n.* ① 风寒; 寒战: I feel a chill, I must have a fever. ② 寒冷; 寒气: There's quite a chill in the air this morning.

> chilly *a.* 寒冷的; 冷淡的

claim /kleɪm/ *vt.* ① 声称; 主张(同义 assert): Don't claim to know what you don't know. ② 索取; 对...提出要求: Has anyone claimed this watch? *n.* ① 要求(同义 demand): Do you have a claim for damages? ② 主张; 断言: His claim to the house is invalid.

collapse /kə'leɪps/ *v. /n.* ① 倒塌; 塌下: The roof collapsed under the weight of the snow. ② 崩溃; 突然失败: If you work too hard, your health may collapse.

communicate /kə'mju:nikeɪt/ *vt.* 传达; 传播: Television communicated the news to all parts of the country. *vi.* 通讯; 交流; 交际: I communicate with him regularly.

> communicative *a.* 好说话的 communication *n.* 传播; 信息

compete /kəm'pi:t/ *vi.* 竞争; 比赛(同义 contest): Nobody can compete with him in speech.

> competitive *a.* 竞争性的 competition *n.* 竞争
