

编者的话

1. Raw Material: School Students

As every school student knows, the important raw materials of industry are coal, oil and iron. But, as every businessman knows, the most important raw material of all is the school student who, as a trained college graduate, will run the U.S. industry of the future. Today U.S. industry is faced with a tight shrinkage of such manpower, it needs not only more but better trained college graduates.

To help get them, many a businessman believes that corporations must provide much of the cash needed by college to expand their facilities and improve their teaching, and work more closely with colleges on business needs. As Robert R. Young pointed out at a White Sulphur Springs conference of businessmen and educators, industry and education have a clear mutuality of interest.

Businessmen and educators have not always recognized this. While there are a few businessmen who still regard college professors as fuzzy-minded and likely to be radical, and a few educators who still look on businessmen as mere money-grabbers, the mutual distrust has generally disappeared in the mutual need. The rapidly expanding U.S. economy has made college graduates more important than ever to industry. In turn, universities must depend increasingly on corporations for contributions, since high taxes have all but⁽³⁾ cut off the flow of the big individual contributions that built the private school.

★ 参考译文

原材料:在校学生

正如学生们所熟知的,煤炭、原油和钢铁是重要的工业原材料,实业家们也深知,在校学生是最重要的原材料。受过训练的大学生将主宰着美国未来的企业发展。当今美国实业界面临着人力资源的匮乏,需要大量的受过良好训练的大学毕业生。

为了获得这类人材,实业界一致认为公司必须向学院提供所需资金以扩充设备,提高教学质量;就商业领域的需求与学校合作。就像罗伯特R·扬在实业界和教育界人士共同参加的白温泉会议上所指出的那样,实业与教育有着明显的互利关系。

实业界和教育界人士并不总能认识到这一点。有些商人仍然 认为学校里的教授们脑筋糊涂,思想激进;有些教育界人士则把商 人看作惟利是图之辈,目前这种相互不信任由于相互需求已经基 本消失了。迅速发展的美国经济使大学毕业生比以往任何时候都 备受实业界的重视。反过来,学校也不得不越来越依赖公司的赞 助,因为高税率几乎切断了创建私立学校的大笔私人捐赠。

2. Professor Smith: My Favourite Teacher

Perhaps the most unforgettable person I have ever met is Prof. Smith who taught us philosophy at university. Although I last met him eight years ago, I still remember his special qualities most distinctively. First of all, I was impressed by his devotion to teaching. Because his lectures were always well-prepared and clearly delivered, students swarmed into his classroom. His followers appreciated the fact that he believed in what he taught and that he was intellectually stimulating. Furthermore, he could be counted on to explain his ideas in an imaginative way, introducing such aids to understanding as paintings, recordings, pieces of sculpture and guest lecturers. Once he even sang a song in class to illustrate a point. Second, I admired the fact that he would meet with students outside of the

classroom or talk to them on the telephone. Sometimes he would challenge a student to a game of chess. At other times, he would join groups to discuss subjects ranging from astronomy to pop music. Finally, I was attracted by his lively wit. He believed that no class hour is a success unless the students and the professor share several chuckles and at least one loud laugh. Through his sense of humor, he made learning more enjoyable and more lasting. If it is true that life makes a wise man smile and a foolish man cry, then Prof. Smith is truly a wise man.

3. Adult Education in the U.S.

Millions of people are enrolled^① in evening adult education programs across America. Community colleges^② have become popular and their enrollments have increased rapidly. Larger universities are offering more courses in the evening for adult students. In this way, the demand for more education is being met. One reason for this is that many older people are changing their professions. They are looking for different careers^③. Another reason is that repair costs have increased. Adults are taking courses like plumbing^④ and electric repair. This way they hope that the high costs for repairs can be avoided. New and advanced technology is the most important for the rise in adult education. Engineers and teachers and businessmen are taking adult education classes. They have found that more education is needed to do their jobs well.

Various courses are offered. Many adult students take computers and business courses. Foreign languages, accounting and communication courses are also popular. Some adult students attend classes to earn degrees, others take courses for the knowledge and skills that they can receive. The lives of many people have been enriched because of adult education.

美国的成人教育

数以百万计的美国人选修了晚间成人教育课程。社区大学

日渐增多,报名人数迅速增长。较有规模的大学晚间向成人提供的课程更多,以满足成人接受继续教育的需求。出现这种情况有两个原因,其一是许多大龄在职人员打算改变自己的职业,他们正寻找新的发展机遇;其二是维修费看涨,成人选修管道、电器维修等课程目的是节省维修费用。高新技术的发展是致使成人教育增长的最重要原因。工程师、教师、商人都在进修成人教育课程,他们发现,做好本职工作需要接受更多的教育。

4. Learning Languages is Easy—or is it?

Have you ever noticed advertisements which say: "learn a foreign language in 6 weeks, or your money back! From the first day your pronunciation will be excellent. Just send..." and so on? Of course, it never happens quite like that. The only language that is easy to learn is the mother tongue. And think how much practice that gets! Before the Second World War people usually learnt a foreign language in order to read the literature of the country. Now speaking the foreign language is what most people want. Every year many millions of people start learning one. How do they do it?

Some people try at home, with books and records or tapes; some use radio, television programmes or computer language learning softwares¹; others go to evening classes. If they use the language only 2 or 3 times a week, learning it will take a long time, like language learning at school. A few people try to learn a language fast by studying for 6 or more hours a day. It is clearly easier to learn the language in the country where it is spoken. However, most people cannot afford² this, and for many it is not necessary. They need the language in order to do their work better. For example,
