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## 前 言

高考英语总复习阶段的时间不算长,但却是十分关键的。复习得法,既能理清英语知识脉络,又能提高英语的实际运用能力;复习不得法,非但收效甚微,有的同学还会感到越复习越糊涂。为了帮助同学们理清高考英语总复习的思路,巩固所学的英语知识,提高英语交际能力,我们根据英语教学大纲和高考考试说明,编写了这本《高考英语知识能力达标训练》。

本书以高考新题型为主线,联结了125个练习。所编练习均源于教学实践, 又高于教学实践,尽力体现"注意交际、强调应用、探索能力检测"的要求。本 书所选文章,体裁各异、内容新颖、信息量大,能较快地提高同学们的篇章阅读能力。每个练习相对独立,但又有一定的相关性和针对性,故同学们可根据 自己的实际需要,安排训练顺序。

本书所编写的四套模拟试卷,可供同学们在做完其他练习后使用,旨在为同学们提供自我评估材料。

由于时间仓促,水平有限,书中难免有误漏及不当之处,敬请读者批评指正。
