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#### 前言

外语学习,除了课堂教学外,还应让学生有机会多接触和多使用外语,这样才能使学生在课堂上所学到的知识得以巩固、发展。所谓多接触、多使用,也就是能够利用一切可能的条件,在课外安排一些有趣味的活动,让学生有机会多听、多读、多作各种有趣的练习,使他们在不增加负担的条件下,通过各项活动不知不觉地进行了复习,同时又扩大了视野。这是提高外语教学质量的一个重要途径。

这本书在编辑过程中,我们针对中学生学习英语的特点,提供了一些内容健康,适合他们理解程度的英语学习材料和有趣的活动方式。其目的在于丰富学生的课余生活,增强他们学习英语的兴趣,又不增加他们的额外负担。我们还注意了联系英语中最常用的习惯口语和短语,采用看图说话的情景活动,短文视听活动,词汇学习的启发式联想等生动活泼的形式,来帮助学生独立思考,巩固学过的知识,提高英语的听、说、读、写的能力。

本书在编写时,根据教育部公布的教育大纲所规定的中学生的英语程度,参考了国外最新的有关资料,并针对了中学生的特点。各项活动和练习的具体方法,本书各章前均有详细说明,读者在活动前应先仔细阅读说明,经过思考、理解后再进行活动。为了收到更好的学习效果,在活动前不要先翻阅答案。最好做完一项练习,再核对答案,检查哪几题作对了,哪一题作错了,或者对原来不会作的习题,经过核

对答案求得正确的知识。本书设计的各章内容各成系统,故可根据条件有选择地进行活动,不必拘泥一章一节的 次序。希望通过这些活动,将使学生得到训练和自我测验,并从中获得新的启发和收获。本书在编写过程中承蒙外国语学院华钧和外国语学校忻韦康两位老师提供了十分宝贵的意见,谨致谢意。
