前 言

英语短语词组既多又杂,且使用中灵活多样,所以在英语学习中占有十分重要的位置。通过对英语短语词组的学习与研究,可以促进学习者牢固掌握英语知识,拓宽在实际语言环境中熟悉英语短语词组用法的视野,使语言表达更加自如、流畅。在现代英语教学和各类英语考试中,短语词组总是作为一项重要的内容被考查、测试。如:在全国英语四、六级统考,研究生入学等考试中,对短语组的考查与测试均占很大比重。但英语短语词组数量很大,不仅难以用字面意义简单总和断定其释义,而且使用时的搭配关系也比较复杂、灵活,在文法上也无一定的规则可以遵循,这就给学习者带来了较大困难。为了解决这一实际问题,我们根据大学英语教学大纲的要求,针对学生的实际状况、四六级考试的需求,并结合多年的教学经验编写了这本书。

在选题方面,我们力图适应大学英语教学大纲对短语词组的要求,在突出全国英语四、六级统考及研究生入学考试中常用的短语词组的同时,也兼顾了目前大学英语统编教材中常用的短语词组。经过反复筛选,收集高频短语词条约 2000 个 , 加以注释, 并辅以大量例句。在编写过程中, 我们参阅了国内外各种词典、语法书, 对较难的词条做了总结归纳。同时, 力图采用通俗的语言、清晰的分类和简明的例句,使读者可以从每个词条和义项的具体例证中了解该短语词组在实际语言环境中的意义和用法。

在体例上,突出该书的实用性。

全书共分3部分:第1部分是常用高频短语释义,精选例句,展现词义及用法;第2部分为试题,共有短语词组类试题600道,试题针对性强,训练范围广;第3部分是答案与精解,便于自查自测。

每部分均按字母表顺序排列,体例编排醒目,易于查检,是不可多得的工具书和备考用书。

本书适用于大学生、研究生和自修者,可以作为工具书和考前强化训练用书。

由于编者水平有限,加之时间仓促,疏漏和错误在所难免,恳请读者斧正。
