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前 言

我们使用的母语——汉语是当今世界上使用人数最多的语言,而英语则是使用最为广泛的语言。随着 21 世纪的到来,随着我国对外开放的深入,我国与世界各国在教育、经济、科技、文化等方面的交往与交流也会日益频繁,学习英语,熟练地运用英语已成为许多人的热切期望。
