



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编者按语

这套丛书是根据美国教师创新教材公司出版的《Brain Teasers —— Critical Thinking Activities》选编的。原版书按年级分为6册，本书将其合并为3个分册，两个年级合为一册。每一分册都原汁原味地收入了原版书两个分册的内容，仅删去了一些原书中各册重复的内容，原书中与《美国小学生课堂练习册》重复的内容，以及一些英语难度太大、文化背景太浓的内容。这套丛书与《美国小学生课堂练习册》是相辅相成的。《课堂练习册》体现了对学习内容的基本要求，注重基础知识和知识的系统性；而《课外练习册》则强调知识的深入、融汇贯通，培养学生的创造性思维，因此比《课堂练习册》难度大、趣味性强、知识面广。

本书适用于我国的中小学生，尤其是双语学校的学生。对于初中生来说，虽然有些内容（特别是数学）显得浅一些，但可以充分利用本书来学习英语知识，丰富英语词汇，提高英语水平。特别是那些打算到英语国家上高中、上大学的学生，学习这套丛书能把国内的学习和国外的学习很好地衔接起来，提前了解和熟悉一下国外的学习生活，无疑是大有裨益的。

这种寓学习于娱乐中的模式正是我国教育体制中所欠缺的。我们的口号是：“英语是玩出来的，而不是学出来的。”


