大学英语六级词汇 高分训练



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词汇是构筑语言这座大厦的基石。在英语学习中,词汇既是学习的难点,也是测试的重点。为了考查学生们对英语词汇的掌握程度,大学英语六级考试还专门采用了词汇测试这一题型。的确,词汇量的多少、词汇应用能力的高低不仅能够衡量出学习者的英语水平,而且还会影响英语学习者的听、说、读、写、译等各种技能的提高与发展。为了帮助英语学习者,尤其是备考六级的学习者快捷有效地突破词汇难关,编者编写了这本以练为主、讲练结合的词汇书。

本书以最新版的《大学英语教学大纲》词汇 表为依据,通过对历年六级全真考题的统计分析,总结其中的规律,并根据这些规律编写而成。

本书主要有以下一些特点:

- 1. 形式新颖 通过对历年六级考题,尤其对词汇部分进行统计分析,编者发现 30 道词汇题中占比例比较大的有同、近义词辨析,形近词词义辨析,介词用法辨析,短语及固定搭配用法辨析。本书正是遵循这一规律将这些考点以专项练习的形式进行编排。这一点也恰好是本书与其它词类词汇书的不同之处。
- 2. 内容全面 全书所练词汇基本涵盖了 《大学英语教学大纲》对六级英语学习所要求掌

握的词汇。另外,在每一套专项练习及综合练习中,本书力求兼顾每一题的代表性及全面性。例如,在同、近义词专项练习中,本书不仅注意训练学习者的同义名词词义辨析能力,而且还注意训练学习者对同义形容词、同义动词、词义现在分词及同义过去分词的辨析能力。通过各种训练,学习者可以更加全面地了解六级考试的针对性,达到举一反三灵活运用的目的。

3. 讲解详实 对专项练习部分的练习,本书给出了答案。对综合练习的每一题,本书除了给出答案外,还对每一个题干进行了翻译,并且对每一选项都作了比较详细的解释,有些还举例予以说明。这样不仅减少了学习者复习备考的盲目性,而且使学习者掌握词汇的来龙去脉,真正实现高分的突破。

本书适用于大学英语六级考试复习备考 者,也适用于准备参加研究生人学考试、MBA 英语考试、公共英语等级(四级)考试的广大读 者。

愿本书能帮助每一位读者把握词汇考试的 脉搏。
