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学习语言如同建造高楼,积累的词汇越多,就好比准备的建筑材料越多。《新概念英语》作为语言学习的经典教材,其词汇也同样经典、实用,是进行语言交际和各级考试的核心词汇。掌握这些词汇,不仅可以扩大词汇量,还可以从中提高自己的交际能力和文化能力。

有鉴于此,编者选取了《新概念英语》的实践与进步及培养技能两个级别(即第二、第三册)的词汇编辑成书。该书的编写和使用有如下特点:

1. 词汇按课文的顺序编排,有利于和课文学习同步。词汇的条目有例句、同义词、同根词、搭配和考点提示,在同类辞书中最为详尽。

2. 本书采用双色排版,词汇采用绿色,醒目、易记。词汇的同义词、同根词、搭配能帮助读者迅速扩展词汇量。

3. 所有释义力求准确、简明。例句有许多来自于时事、时尚,既典型又贴近生活,使你从生动有趣的句子中,轻松地掌握词汇,同时还可作为学习口语和英美文化的蓝本。

4. 针对中、高考及参加其他考试的读者,我们在考点说明中对主要词汇的搭配、辨异进行了说明。另外,还从每课中特意选出常考的词汇和短语,列在课后单独说明。

5. 本书每五课为一单元,在每单元后编写了词汇练习,供读者及时检测和复习。

6. 本书特意做了第二册与第三册词汇的索引,一是便于读者查阅词汇,二可作为风暴式记忆词汇的蓝本。

7. 附录Ⅰ收录了近年的高考题(词汇部分),附录Ⅱ收录了大学英语一至四级测试题(词汇部分),参加高考的读者和其他水平的读者可对照测试自己的词汇量。

本书适合于新概念英语的广大读者,参加中、高考的中学生和其他各级读者。相信本书会给读者带来益处,并欢迎批评指正。

最后,还要特别感谢王敏、周健华、于立坤、龚嵘、王慧、李琳、秦宇等对本书编写的热情帮助和支持。

a. 友好的 **同** kind **例** I'm greatly impressed by the friendly and hospitable Chinese people. 友好慷慨的中国人民给我留下了深刻印象。

[同根词] friend *n.* 朋友

[考点提示] 该词虽以词缀“-ly”结尾,但是形容词而非副词: be friendly with sb. 对某人友善。
