这套教材含学生用书、教师用书及录音磁带。

学生用书共分三册,前两册以日常生活为题材,从学生熟悉的身边事开始,循序渐进,以培养学生的综合听力水平。第三册中的商贸英语,重点对学生进行岗位训练;求职应试英语,旨在帮助学生顺利求职,轻松通过面试。

教师用书包括:听力材料的全文及练习、参考答案,必要的注解以及某些专业知识介绍,这主要是为那些非贸易专业学生进行讲解时用的,教师可根据情况进行取舍。

录音磁带共十盒,包括全部课文和练习要求的录音,由外籍教师按顺序录制。

教材中的口语练习部分是为了给学生提供一个与课文所学内容相 关的训练素材,教师可根据学生掌握的情况来安排教学时间。
