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### 内容简介

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
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
## 前言



教学实践表明,词汇能力是构成语言能力的重要因素,词义理解和搭配用法是词汇能力的核心。本书根据中华人民共和国教育部印发的最新《大学英语教学大纲通用词汇表(5~6级)》所规定的1300个单词以及由这些单词构成的常用词组编写而成。全书共分20单元,每单元由4节组成,1至3节各有16个单词,第四小节有17个单词。每一小节后配有练习题10个,全书共配有练习题800题。每单元后给出练习答案。

难词辩异

每个单词的讲解由【考点】、【记忆】和【例 句】组成。【考点】是本书的重点部分,为了让 考生正确地把握好该词的使用语境和搭配关 系,该部分从用法和搭配等方面详细地讲解该 词。【记忆】部分是本书的一大特色,编者没有 像目前市场上的很多词汇书那样罗列大量的同 根词、同形词以及前缀和后缀,而是结合学生已 经掌握的四级词汇及中学词汇,让考生巧妙地 记忆六级词汇,起到了事半功倍的作用。在本 书的【例句】部分,几乎每个单词都配有例句, 以利于考生根据一定的语言环境记忆该词, 尤 其是编者还尽量给出【考点】中提到的该词的 搭配以及用法,让同学们重复记忆,加深印象。 所给例句简洁、有趣、典型,便干记忆。本书所 选的练习题在难易度以及句子的长度上非常接 近大学英语六级真题水平,并且有目的地、有针




## 前言




