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前言

《大学英语》精读(文理科用)是由国家教委审定批准,根据《大学英语教学大纲(文理科本科用)》(以下简称《大纲》)编写的教材,目前为全国高等院校广泛使用。

理解和记忆词汇,掌握和运用词汇举足轻重,是学好英语的关键。由此我们编写了《大学英语精读词汇》(分级、释义、作文、记词)一书,以配合大学英语教学,满足广大读者的迫切需要。

《大学英语精读词汇》分上、下册出版。上册含《大学英语精读》1—2册,下册含3—4册。全书内容编排与教材同步,词条以相关课文词汇表顺序编排。每个词条一般由以下几个部分组成:词目、音标、词级、基本构词、同义词(Syn.)或反义词(Ant.)、词性、释义、例证和短语。

本书以《大纲》为依据,对词目以及词目下属词义项和短语标明词级。词级共分 3 级: E 级(Elementary)为中学词汇, I 级(Intermediate)为 1—4 级词汇,A 级为 5—6 级词汇。词目下词义项中,先列出课文出现的词义。《大纲》以外的词汇和短语不标词级。这种词级的划分有利于读者在学习词汇时区别对待,分清主次。同时为教师有重点地进行词汇教学提供参考依据。

根据《大纲》要求,掌握前缀、后缀等基本构词以识别新词,扩大词汇量。采用同义联想和反义对比有效地记忆词汇。由此,词条中的构词、同义词和反义词旨在帮助读者快速记忆词汇,以期取得事半功倍的效果。

本书词义项附例说明用法,例证力求简明规范,通俗易懂,体现词义和用息,例后不附汉泽,其目的是希望读者直

接通过原文句子,培养英语的思维能力,增强语感。

《大学英语精读词汇》上册由汤德纲、方飞雷两位副教授主编。参加编写的有:浙江丝绸工学院方飞雷副教授(第一册 1-5课),浙江大学汤德纲副教授(第一册 6-10课),浙江工业大学贝聿建副教授(第二册 1-5课)、吴燮元副教授(第二册 6-10课)。

本书为《大学英语》精读配套用书,可与精读教材同步 使用,可供文理科大学生、英语自学者以及英语教师参考之 用。

由于时间仓促,编者学识与经验有限,书中疏漏和错误在所难免,敬请读者批评指正,使本书渐臻完善。
