In the past, operations were difficult. Until the middle of the eighteen fifties, surgery was very dangerous. Many patients died, after even the smallest operations. A person who likes to think about travel and faraway places, but who really prefers to stay at home, is known as an "armchair traveller". Jules Verne, the worldfamous writer, was such a man.

In his imagination, he travelled to places where nobody had ever been before. He went round the world in eighty days, which of course was impossible to do in the nineteenth century.
