




Britain's education system operates (Example) at (Q30) levels — pri-
mary, (Q31) and tertiary. Before primary, there are few places for (Q32)

Compulsory schooling provided by the state takes place between the ages of 5 and
16. Children from 5 to 6 go to (Q33) school and those from 7 to 11 to the
(Q34) school. In infant and junior schools alike, each class has about 30
students. One teacher is assigned to teach them all their subjects.
Children stay in the secondary school from 11 through (Q35) The
majority of Britain's secondary schools are (Q36) schools, which means
that they take both boys and girls and that they take children of all abilities.
Children study more specialized subjects like foreign languages and sciences in sec-
ondary schools. (Q37) is the most popular foreign language studied. And
after French come German, Spanish and Italian. Other important subjects include music
and sport.
At the end of their schooling, British children can take national exams, usually the
General Certificate of Education, or (Q38), at two levels — Ordinary level

There are usually three criteria by which a student will be judged for further educa-
tion. The first is his GCE exam results; the second the (Q39) he gets from
