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前言

本书是“雅思新突破系列丛书”中的一册,共有 10 套雅思听力全真模拟试题。与市场上现有的雅思听力模拟试题相比,明显具有以下突出的优点:

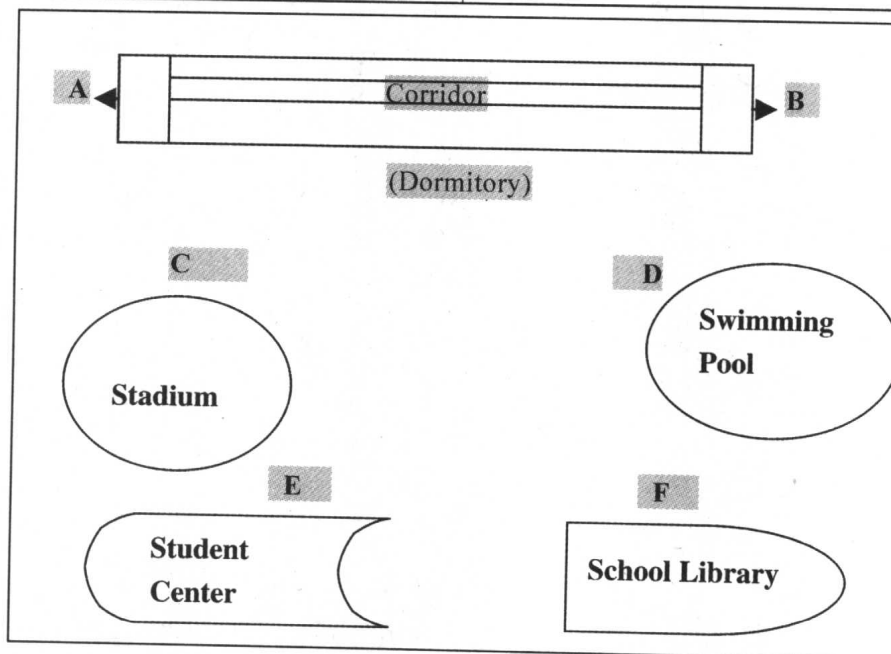
