

前言

《新概念英语》是英国语言学家 L. G. Alexander 编著的系列教材。由于该书所具有的特点,我国的大、中专学校,无论是英语专业,还是文、理、工等专业都广泛采用它作教材;不少的英语爱好者乐于将此书作为系统的自学读本。近年来,国内已陆续出版了不少该书的中译本和辅导材料,为学习本书的读者解决了一定的困难。但这个为止,尚无一套用于读者自己检测掌握该书程度的完整试题。为了使广大自学者随时了解自己学习《新概念英语》所达到的程度,特编写此书。

本书面对众多的《新概念英语》辅导材料,力求扬长避短。 在编写过程中,参照《新概念英语》的体系及编写意图,力图从 内容上、结构上、立意上体现新颖性、实用性,目的在于在检测 读者学习《新概念英语》学习效果的同时帮助提高使用英语的 能力。

在内容上,本书的测试范围包括语音、词汇、语法、短语辨析、惯用法、阅读与理解等,以便读者对自己的学习效果作全面的了解。

在形式上,本书全部采用选择填空形式,以减少读者的答题时间。

在结构上,本书与《新概念英语》课本配套。全套书分上、下两册出版,上册包括《新概念英语》第一、二册,下册包括《新概念英语》第一册用综合题测试 概念英语》第一册用综合题测试外,其他均分单元测试。

全书附有参考答案和详细的注释,以便读者举一反三,触类旁通。它与《新概念英语》相配,成为完备实用的英语自学读本。对有关大、中专学校及使用《新概念英语》的中学师生亦颇具参考价值。
