

前言

FOREWORD

There are already a great number of books on English Conversation available in China; but it appears that none of them had been compiled with the specific purpose of meeting the requirements of students of tourism.

Most of the existing books limit themselves to the use of words that are dignified and beyond reproach, scarcely touching phrases or sentences of everyday use—such as "You bet;" or "I won't buy your story;"—which should definitely be within the vocabulary of students interested in meeting people and in "thalking the language" of their friends who have come from the other side of the world.

It should also be remembered that when the average Westerner speaks about a "second language," he may be referring to one which had not presented much difficulty to him. A Spaniard could learn to speak Portuguese, or Italian, or French tolerably well without serious effort. But a Chinese, learning to speak English has to face a great many more problems. It would be better for him to refrain at the beginning from using big and awe-inspiring words. It would be no condescension for him to use simple words only.

Interpreting and translating from one language to another is always an intricate and interesting experience. A good translator of serious matter-from important documents to well-known literature—would make every effort to adhere

strictly to the original text. But a good interpreter in a tourist office can legitimately entertain certain other notions, such as making it easier for the visitor to understand, and for the smoothing over of difficulties, with a wise crack or a famous saying. For this reason, a number of proverbs have been included and translated in this compilation, and in some cases, the translation may not even correspond to the originals from a strictly literal point of view.

Then, the choice of subjects to be included in the books on conversation should fit the needs of the students. This book attempts to serve those of tourism primarily, and does not pretend to be an introduction to the study of serious English literature. Here, besides numerous sentences and phrases that could be used in daily speech, a number of single words have been added to increase the vocabulary of the student. Also, a list of sentences and phrases colloquially and widely used in the United States has been attached at the end of book.
