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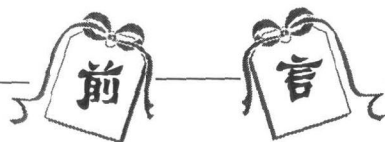

大学英语四级考试是大学英语提高阶段的水平考试。考生在准备四级考试时,往往更为注重考试技能的获得,而忽略了对基础知识的扎实掌握。而所谓的基础知识和考试技能均来自于历年真题。因此笔者从分析 2000 年 1 月至 2003 年 9 月大学英语四级考试真题入手,归纳必须掌握的核心词汇和语法,提炼出题形式和命题规律,点拨应试技巧,并据此给出模拟训练。

本书分三篇:基础知识篇、应试技巧篇和实战模拟篇。基础知识篇分析 2000 年 1 月至 2003 年 9 月大学英语四级考试真题,归纳出核心词汇和核心语法结构;应试技巧篇揭示各部分考题规律和应试技巧;实战模拟篇精选四套模拟试题。其突出特点如下:

### 1. 基础知识篇

归纳真题核心词汇和语法。所谓核心词汇,是指这些词汇和语法是答题的关键,即考点。一共归纳出 650 个核心词汇。核心词汇来自四部分:听力理解、阅读理解、词汇和完形填空。核心词汇均有例句,并有译文。例句来自真题,真实可信。

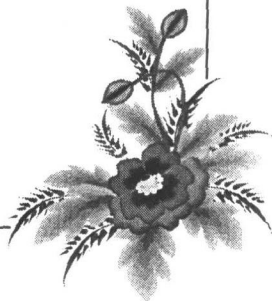

### 2. 应试技巧篇

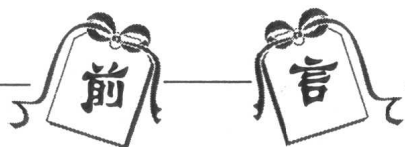

精选四套模拟试题,并给出试题详解。

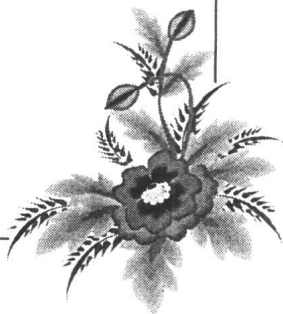

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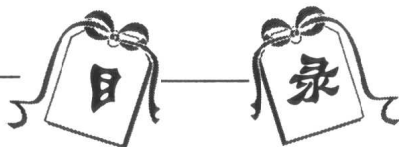
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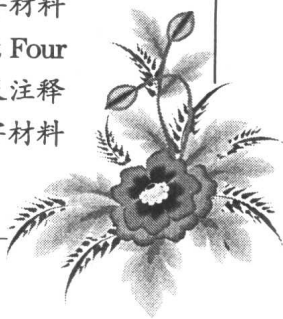
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第一篇 基础知识篇

词汇和语法知识是大学英语四级考试各部分的基础,无论考生的应试技能有多高,都离不开一定的词汇和语法知识。因此,该篇分析了9套四级考试真题(2000年1月~2003年9月),归纳了9次考试各部分所有核心词汇和语法。所谓核心,是指这些词汇和语法是答题的关键,即考点。该部分所有例句均来自四级考试真题,以保证分析的真实可信。

**actually 2003.6.10** *ad.* 实际上地,事实上地

It's **actually** even worse, believe it or not. 不管你信不信,难极了。

**advertise 2003.6.14** *v.* 为……做广告,登广告

The **advertising** world is very competitive. 广告界里的竞争非常激烈。

**advertisement 2002.6.9** *n.* 广告

Excuse me, I'd like to place an **advertisement** for a used car in the Sunday edition of your paper. 打扰一下,我想在你们报纸的周日版上刊登一则二手车的广告。

**application 2002.6.10** *n.* 申请(表);应用

I spent so much time polishing my letter of **application**. 我花了好多时间来修改我的申请信。

**appointment 2000.1.6 (with)** *vt.* 与某人约会,约定;委派

I'm just ringing to confirm my **appointment** with Mr. Smith for this afternoon. 我打电话只是确认一下我今天下午与 Mr. Smith 的约会。

**assignment 2002.1.2** *n.* 任务;作业;分配

Did you find the book for your reading **assignment** in the library? 你在图书馆找到了有关阅读作业方面的书吗?

**assist 2002.1.7** *v.* 帮助,协助(*assistant n.* *assistance n.*)

He **assists** Professor Williams with his teaching. 他为威廉姆斯教授作助教。

**assume 2002.6.12** *v.* 假定,承担;呈现

The reasons why people don't read newspapers are more complicated than **assumed**. 人们不读报的原因比原来所想象的要复杂得多。

**authority 2001.1.16** *n.* 当权者;权威,权利

In some places, the education **authorities** tried to arrange special travelling schools for Gypsy children. 有些地方,教育当局设法为吉普赛人的子女安排流动学校。

**average 2003.1.17** *n.* 平均;平常(*adj. v.*)

That is an **average** of more than 20 million metric tons every year. (这些被扔掉的生物)每年平均超过两千万公吨。

**award 2003.6.20** *v.* 授予,判给

...but it was not until 1948 that they were **awarded** degrees. 但是直到1948年才给她们授学位。

**awfully 2000.1.7** *ad.* 极坏的,可怕的;非常的(*awful adj.*)

Tom looks **awfully** nervous, doesn't he? Yes, I'm afraid he's not used to making speeches. Tom 看上去真紧张,是吧? 是的,恐怕他不适应做讲演。

**block out 2000.1.18** 遮挡,挡住

Would black powder in the smoke from the fires circle the globe and **block out sun**? 大火产生的黑色粉尘和烟雾会不会弥漫在空中把太阳遮住呢?

**branch 2002.6.17 n.** 树枝,分支

Not all birds make their homes in **branches**. Some birds build their nests on the ground, ... 不是所有的鸟都把巢筑在树枝间,有些鸟把巢筑在地上……

**break down 2002.1.1** 损坏;垮掉

Sorry, the computer **broke down** this morning.对不起,今天上午计算机坏了。

**bring sb. up to date on 2001.1.3 n.** 帮某人赶上……

I will try to **bring you up to date on** what we've done.我来帮你把耽搁的课补上。

**buy out 2000.1.8** 买下全部股份(产权)

A few? It looks like you **bought out** the bookstore! 不多?你把书店都要买空了?

**cancel 2002.6.4 v.** 取消,抵消;删去

But if it does rain, the whole thing will have to be **cancelled**.但是如果下雨的话,整个计划必须取消。

**cancer 2001.6.14 n.** 癌症

...such as whether you will develop heart disease, or **cancer**. ... 比如是否会患心脏病或癌症。

**care 2000.6.16 v.** 关心,担心;对……介意

The most important part you can play is to be there. You can let your friends know that you **care**.你能做的最重要的事情就是陪伴他,让他知道你在关心他。

**chase 2000.1.13 v.** 追逐,追捕

He was so busy **chasing** his car that he did not get the name of the driver of the sports car, ... 因为忙于追自己的车,他无法得知跑车司机的名字,……

**cleanup 2000.1.20 n.** 把……收拾干净,清理

Officials are trying to organize a quick **cleanup**, ... 官员们正在尽力组织快速清理,……

**collect 2001.1.13 v.** 收集,采集

Of course, the tax collector managed to **collect** more money than he paid to the ruler. 当然,收税者会设法收取高于他要上缴的金额。

**come through 2002.1.3** 通过;安然度过

Yes, the power indicator was on and it was running, but somehow the sound didn't **come through**. 是的,电源灯亮着,机器在运转,但是就是没有声音。

**commit 2003.9.19 v.** 犯(错误、罪行等)

If the telephone rings at three in the morning, he knows it's trouble. Someone is threatening to **commit suicide**.如果电话在凌晨3点响起,他就知道麻烦来了。有人威胁要自杀。

**communication with 2003.9.20** 与……交流,交际,通讯

The trick is to open a channel of **communication** with them.策略就是打通和他们交流的通道。

**community 2002.1.15 n.** 社区,社会;团体

And some are allowed out of the ground to study or do **community work**.有些还被允许到监狱外学习或者去社区劳动。

**company** 2002.6.2 *n.* 公司;陪伴;交往

Look, it says they want a junior Sales Manager and it seems like it's a big company. 看,上面说他们想要一个年轻的销售经理,看起来像是一个大公司。

**complicated** 2001.1.17 *adj.* 复杂的

The causes are very complicated. 原因是非常复杂的。

**complicated** 2002.6.12 *adj.* 复杂的,难懂的

Recent surveys, however, have indicated that the portrait on the non-reader is more complicated than first thought. 但是,最近的调查表明这些“不能阅读的人”的特征比我们最初想象的要复杂。

**concentrate on** 2002.1.6 全神贯注,集中 (*concentration n.*)

She will stop working and concentrate on her studies 她将停止工作,集中精力学习。

**conclude** 2002.6.20 *v.* 推论出;结束

The scientists concluded that solar wind activity must follow the same cycle. 科学家们得出这样的结论:太阳风的活动一定也是遵循同样的循环规律。

**confirm** 2000.1.6 *vt.* 确认,证实,批准

I'm just ringing to confirm my appointment with Mr. Smith for this afternoon. 我打电话只是确认一下我今天下午与 Mr. Smith 的约会。

**congratulation** 2001.6.1 *n.* 贺词,祝贺,恭喜

I heard you got full marks in the math exam. Congratulations! 我听说你数学考试得了满分。祝贺你!

**consider** 2003.1.18 *v.* 考虑;认为;关心

When you consider that equals a quarter of the world's catch, you begin to see the size of the problem. 当你考虑到这是世界捕鱼量的四分之一时,你就看到了这个问题的严重性。

**continue** 2001.6.2 *v.* 继续,延伸

It wasn't as easy as I have thought. I have to continue doing it tonight. 没有我想象的那么容易。我今天晚上还得继续做。

**crash into** 2000.1.11 *v.* 碰撞,坠落;闯;垮台

It crashed into a bus at the bottom of the hill, and was so badly damaged that it had to be pulled away to a garage. 他的汽车在山脚下撞上了一辆公交车,受损非常严重,不得不将它拖到修理厂去修理。

**crisis** 2003.6.16 *n.* 危机,决定性时刻

The crisis came when my wife left me. 当妻子离开我的时候我才意识到了事情的严重性。

**cross** 2001.6.16 *v.* 穿过,越过;使交叉 (*n.* 十字架,十字路口)

Such thoughts may have crossed your mind once in a while. 这些想法也许会在你的脑海里闪过。

**crossword puzzle** 2003.1.3 字谜游戏

It's only a crossword puzzle that helps increase my vocabulary. 这是可以扩大词汇量的拼字谜游戏。

**deal with** 2003.1.19 处理,解决

... some countries are beginning to deal with this problem, but it is vital we find rational ways of fishing before every ocean becomes a dead sea. ... 一些国家开始处理这个问题,但是重要的是在每一个海洋成为死海之前,我们要找到合理的捕鱼方法。

**delay** 2002.6.8 *v.* 延误,耽误

But I'm sorry the flight is delayed because of a minor mechanical problem. 但是,对不起,这一航班因为一个小的机械故障而延误。

**delicious** 2000.1.2 *adj.* 美味的,有趣的

Very delicious indeed. Even my mother's can't match this. 非常好吃。甚至比我母亲做的还要好吃。

**departure time** 2002.6.8 离开(出发)时间

The plane's departure time remains unknown 飞机的起飞时间还是个未知数。

**desperate** 2000.1.16 *adj.* 绝望的,极需要的

I was getting desperate. 我简直是绝望了。

**direction** 2003.6.17 *n.* 方向;指引;说明书

But no one could point at any one direction because there is no campus. 没有人能够指着一个方向(告诉你哪儿是剑桥大学),因为那儿没有校园。

**distant** 2001.6.13 久远的,在远处的;冷淡的

You probably don't spend much time worrying about the distant future, 你也许不愿多花时间为遥远的未来而忧虑。

**downtown** 2003.9.2 *ad.* 在城市的商业区; *adj. n.* 城市商业区(的)

I'd like to live in the downtown area near my work. 我愿意住在离上班较近的城区。

**drama** 2000.6.8 *n.* 戏,剧本;戏剧性的事件 *adj.* 戏剧性的

Well, some people just can't seem to appreciate real-life drama. 有些人好象不喜欢现实剧。

**draw near** 2002.6.6 接近,靠近

Should he do that when the final exam is drawing near? 周末考试即将来临,(他怎么还在玩游戏)?

**drop by (in)** 2003.6.2 顺便访问

I wonder if you can drop by tomorrow evening. 你明天晚上能到我这儿来一趟吗?

**due** 2003.1.6 *adj.* 到期的;应给的,应付的

It isn't due until Thursday morning. 直到周四上午才交。

**earn** 2002.1.20 *v.* 赚得,挣得

Leamer drivers are not allowed to work and earn money as drivers. 学员司机不准靠驾驶挣钱。

**emotionally** 2001.6.12 *ad.* 感情上地,情绪激动地; (*emotional adj.*)

Basically, you want to feel good physically, mentally, and emotionally now. 基本上你是希望目前在身体、精神和情感上有良好的感觉。

**employ** 2003.9.12 *vt.* 雇用;使用 *n.* 受雇,雇佣

They usually employ college students to do the cleaning and washing up. 他们通常雇用一些大学生来做清洁工作。

**enjoy** 2003.6.1 *v.* 享受,喜爱

More and more people enjoy eating out now. 现在越来越多的人喜欢在外面吃饭。

**ensure** 2003.1.16 *vt.* 保证,担保,确保

Big, high-tech fleets ensure that everything in their path is pulled out of water. 大的高科技舰队肯定能把他们所经过的海域中的海洋生物从水中翻出。

**entitle to** 2003.9.14 *vt.* 给……权利,给……资格

Peter had won a contest promoted by a Waltemore radio station. The first prize entitled him to enter the Union Trust Bank, and gather up as much money as he could lay his hands on within five minutes. 彼得·约翰逊在 Waltemore 电台的节目中获得了头奖,可以走进 Union Trust Bank 在5分钟之内愿拿多少钱就拿多少钱。

**entitled to** 2003.6.19 给……权利;给……资格

It has more than 60 specialist subject libraries as well as the university library, which as a copyright library, is **entitled to** a copy of every book published in Britain. 作为一个版权图书馆除了有权得到英国出版的每一种图书的一本之外,它还有 60 多个专业图书馆。

**expose to** 2003.1.8 使处于……作用(或影响)下

I'm **exposed to** the thoughts of some of the world's best writers. 我接触了世界上一些大作家的思想。

**failure** 2001.1.19 *n.* 失败

But the type of accidents continued to rise because of human **failure** and an enormous increase in the numbers of automobiles on the road. 但是由于人为的失误以及马路上车辆的猛增,事故的类型在增加。

**feel** 2000.6.15 *v. n.* 感觉,觉得

They want to feel better or feel happy or to feel nothing. 他们想感觉好一些,或者感觉愉快一些,或者感觉麻木些。

**figure out** 2003.9.4 想出,理解,明白

Anyhow, let's calm down and try to **figure things out**. 不管怎样,我们要先平静下来想办法解决问题。

**finally** 2000.6.5

After two sleepless nights, I'm **finally** through with it.. 经历了两个不眠之夜我终于写完了。

**finance and economics** 2002.1.10 金融

I have studied almost everything about **finance and economics**. 我研究了有关金融和经济学的全部东西。

**firmly** 2003.6.12 *ad.* 坚定地,坚决地,稳固地

"Cut that section again!" he said **firmly**, "and don't make me have to tell you again." "再割一遍",他非常坚定地对我说,"不要让我再告诉你一遍。"

**fit into** 2000.6.11 适合,合适

Most students, who **fit into** this third group have a clear idea about what they want to learn. 第三类学生大多数都清楚自己需要学什么。

**focus** 2001.6.11 *v.* (on)使聚焦,集中;(注意,活动)的中心

If you are a young college student, most of your concerns about your health and happiness in life are probably **focused** on the present. 如果你是一名大学生,你很可能把注意力放在眼前的健康和生活上。

**forecast** 2000.6.9 *n.* 预测,预报

Yes, the **forecast** says it's going to get worse before it warms up. 是的,天气预报说天气在转暖之前还会变冷。

**fortunately** 2001.1.4 *ad.* 幸运地,幸亏(*fortunate adj.*)

**Fortunately**, her father loves to fish, so we will have something to talk about. 好在她的父亲喜欢钓鱼,因此我们就有话可谈了。

**gather up** 2003.9.17 收集,采集;集中

...and **gather up** as much money as he could lay his hands on within five minutes. Because he could not bring any large sacks or boxes into the bank, all the money had to be placed in his pockets. 在 5 分钟之内愿拿多少钱就拿多少钱。因为他不能把大的口袋或箱子带进银行,所有的钱必须放在他的口袋里。

**get sth. changed** 2000.1.9 更改,改变

I'll have to **get my ticket changed**. 我得去换机票。

**go through** 2002.1.17 获得通过;经历;仔细检查

The reason why London drivers are so efficient is that they have all **gone through** a very tough training period

to get a special taxi driving license. 伦敦的出租车司机工作效率高,是因为要取得驾驶执照他们必须经过一段非常艰苦的培训。

**hang about 2000.6.10** 在……转悠

You were seen **hanging about** the store on the night when it was robbed, weren't you? 商店被抢的那天晚上,有人看见你在那里闲逛。

**hurry 2003.6.6** *n. v.* 匆忙,急忙;催促

There is no **hurry**. 不要急。

**impression 2002.1.8** *n.* 印象,感觉;印记

I was under the **impression** that the tickets were sold out a long time ago. 我的印象是票早就卖完了。

**in case of 2002.6.4** 假如,防备

They will not do as planned **in case of** rain 假如下雨他们将不能按计划执行。

**income tax 2001.1.12** *n.* 收入税,所得税

And in this way he paid his **income tax** for the year. This was a simple way of collecting income tax. 通过这种方法,他就算交纳了当年的所得税。这是收所得税的一种简单方式。

**income 2002.6.11** *n.* 收入,所得,收益

Early research has shown that non-readers are generally low in education, low in **income**, either very young or very old. 早期的研究表明这些“不能阅读的人”不是很年轻就是很年长,并且受教育的水平和收入水平都比较低。

**increasingly 2001.6.17** 日益,越来越多地

...such health related are likely to become **increasingly** important to you... 这些与健康有关的考虑对你来说会变得越来越重要。

**indicate 2002.6.12** *v.* 指出,表明;指示

Recent surveys, however, have **indicated** that the portrait on the non-reader is more complicated than first thought. 但是,最近的调查表明这些“不能阅读的人”的特征比我们最初想象的要复杂。

**injury 2000.1.14** *n.* 受伤,伤害
