編輯前言

- 一、本書使用對象包括:一般社會人士、高中生、大專生;而高中生 用來當作英文作文參考書,尤其適用。
- 二、本書主要特色是: 把英文作文、或一般英文寫作時常用到的句型,以單字為單位,把它們全部列出來,每個句型另附上例句或 片語。

三、本書使用方法:

- ①如果您是一名高中生,請您將此書随時携帶,逐字的把句型和 例句一一背誦或誦讀,也就是把這本書當作「讀本」使用; 當您熟讀此書之後,英文作文的能力一定在不知不覺中進步神 速。
- ②如果您是一名在社會上工作的人士、或大專學生,則您可採取 如高中生(上述①)使用的方式;或者,把它置於案頭,在寫 英文文章、書信時,遇有句法困難隨時查考。
