前　言

雅思IELTS)作为一项国际化的标准语言测试，致力于对非英语国家英语学习者的语言水平进行全面、公正地衡量，在其二十多年的发展史中，雅思考试的科学性早已得到国际上的认可。作为国内最大的出国语言培训机构之一，环球天下教育集团（以下简称“环球集团”）十几年来精益求精，不断完善雅思课程体系并升级配套教材。

本书从属于环球集团第八套教材系列丛书。相比之前的口语教材，本书在编排体系和内容素材上都有了根本性的突破，特点主要体现在：

1. 话题最全，涵盖最新话题。

本书以雅思考试口语“机经”为蓝本，收录雅思口语高频话题，更实时更新最新考题，对雅思口试Part One, Part Two, Part Three中各类话题进行了完整收录。其中，Part One涵盖五大类别，共计56个话题；Part Two涵盖五大类别，共计135个话题；Part Three涵盖五大类别，共计57个话题。

2. 例题为高频或难度大、有代表性的题目。

雅思口语考试的备考难点之一在于考题会不定期更换，但好在有相当一部分题目是雅思口试的“保留项目”。这些考题在历年的考试中反复出现，很多所谓“新题”无非是在这些经典题的基础上稍加变化。本书以雅思口试中的经典题为例，加以“考题分析”和“技巧点评”。学生如果没有时间把庞大的口语题库里的话题逐个准备，则可以重点准备例题，举一反三。

3. 例题由一线教师点评。

书中例题由环球集团一线明星教师撰写点评，权威、实用，内容丰富细致，针对不同英语水平的考生常犯的错误进行集中剖析，提出规避错误的方案，全面解析各类话题的应对方法以及提分要点，为学生备考指点迷津。

4. 所有命题及范文均为外籍考官撰写。

书中所列命题及范文均为外籍考官撰写。从考官角度掌控得分要点，题目难度贴近历次考试真题，且跨度安排合理。语言地道规范，契合雅思口语考试的高分要求。

5. 难度级别涵盖了基础、强化和高分段。

本书是一本操作性极强的雅思口语全方位培训教材。全书先从雅思口语考试规则、评分标准、考生常见疑问等方面介绍，然后分析考生的实际情况，给出雅思口语备考的应答技巧，从合理运用连接词、尽量拓展要点、高效简要地速记到其他备考策略。这些可以帮助考生快速理清答题思路，确保逻辑的严密性和表述的流畅性。

本书从第三章开始列出了雅思口语Part One到Part Three中高频话题和最新的话题和涵

盖了不同的难度级别，因而适用于各分数段的雅思口语课程教学。学生可以按照自身英语水平选择合适话题，由易到难加以练习。

6. 既适用于课堂教学，也适用于课后自学。

本书亦可用于课堂教学，教师可针对书中所述答题技巧进行详细讲解；还可用于课后自学，学生可揣摩话题范文、熟记话题词汇、练习重点语法。

7. 发音为标准英式语音。

为了能给考生提供标准、地道、最贴近考官要求的语音，本书所有范文均为英籍雅思口语命题研究组录制。

在此，预祝所有的雅思考生考试顺利，考取理想的分数，提高口语能力。

使用说明

全书除附录外可分为两个部分。前面五章内容为第一部分，是全书的主体，其组成部分包括：

◆ Chapter One: General Introduction

此章全面介绍了雅思口语的内容和形式，深入剖析了口语的四项评分标准及拿分要点，并针对常见的认知误区进行辨析，让考生真正了解此项考试。

雅思口语 9 分有些可遇不可求，需要天时、地利、人和。但大家也不妨看一下 9 分达人可以达到的境界：

Fluency and Coherence

- speaks fluently with only rare repetition or self-correction
- any hesitation is content-related rather than words or grammar
- speaks coherently with fully appropriate cohesive features
- develops topics fully and appropriately

考生在表达过程中极少有重复和停顿；若有停顿也是因为思考讲话内容而出现的自然停顿，而不是在语言表达上卡住了；表达内容连贯、衔接合理；合理充分地展开话题。

◆ Chapter Two: Skills Preparation

此章展示了考生在口语中可以用来提分的一些技巧：如何使用各种连接方式，如何把话说长，如何让自己的词汇和句式更为丰富及如何在 Part Two 记笔记等。这些技巧在下面章节中的点评里有更具体的阐述。

连词的使用对提高英语口头表述的连贯性有很重要的意义。如果考生在考试的时候只会重复使用简单连词 and/but/so 等，考官在这一项最多打 5 分，因此想要得高分的考生必须练习使用多种连词。大体说来，英语中的连词可以用来表述下述逻辑关系：

顺序	并列、增补	举例	转折、对比

◆ Chapter Three: General Topics of Part One

此章展示了 Part One 常考话题及高分范例。这一章将 Part One 的问题分成了五大主题，包括：Basic Information, Daily Routines and Activities, Hobbies and Entertainment, Abilities and Skills 以及 People and Animals。每个主题下面细分的话题涵盖

思路点拨

问题一为特殊疑问句；问题二为特殊疑问句 + 特殊追问；问题三为选择疑问句 + 特殊追问；问题四为一般疑问句 + 特殊追问。

回答问题一时需注意时态，再延展。问题二和问题四需先回答问题，再展开。问题三需考生先做出选择而后再展开。前两个询问个人习惯的问题，都可以分情况讨论，使用 I think it really depends. 的结构。

问题三偏好选择疑问句，可以运用对比进行扩展，比较对象的优缺点，如：I would like to keep small things in pockets because it's easy to get. Although the bag is quite roomy, it's a lot of trouble to carry.

注意：It depends. 也可以使用 It depends on sth. 的结构，可是如果加了介词，则必须把 sth. 说完整。如问题一至问题三，可以说 I think it really depends on the weather conditions. 回答问题三时不可只简单回答，要展开自己的理由，因为简单回答是典型的不完整回答。

了近几年雅思口试Part One的绝大部分话题。每个话题都针对典型问题给出了相应的思路点拨、高分范例，并针对重点词汇和语法做出了标注。

◆ Chapter Four: General Topics of Part Two

此章讲Part Two常考话题，分成了People and Animals, Events and Experiences, Objects and Items, Places and Architecture, Media and Entertainment五个主题，每个主题下面列出数十个常考话题卡并给出题型透析、考点提示、思路点拨、高分范例、必备词汇、精彩语句和核心语法。

本书主体部分可用于课堂讲解。讲师应注重技巧，使学生得以举一反三。答案部分可用于自学。学生应着眼于分析示例答案中的答题技巧，并针对重点的词汇语法进行强化记忆。应当注意的是，高分范例只能用作参考，考生不宜全文背诵。背诵一来费时费力，二来会使考生与考官交流时显得机械呆板。
