"为什么学习英语?"很多学生都会发出这样的疑问。是为了 大学英语等级考试,为了出国旅游时与人交流,还是为了和外国 人交朋友,或是为了听懂原版英文电影电视剧?如果是我回答这 个问题,我想答案有两种:第一,学英语是为了阅读英文原版读 物,不仅是小说、散文等消遣读物,更多是与自身行业专业有关 的专业资料,以便迅速掌握尖端技术,从而提升在职场中的核心 竞争力。第二,学习英语也是为了在工作中顺利、高效地进行商 务交流。

在当今迅速发展的全球一体化的时代,英语是国际交流中占主导地位的一门重要语言,用英文进行交流也是各行各业专业人士的必备技能。或许,目前作为大学生的你,在大学英语课堂中反复练习日常英语口语,用英语打招呼、谈谈自己的兴趣爱好并不成问题,但是涉及专业知识或是办公室情景时却不知道如何开口;或许你初入职场,虽然有一定的英语水平,但是对各行各业的专业英语并不熟悉,更不知道如何在工作中进行专业的交流与沟通。面对就业的前景与压力,解决英语口语在专业领域的应用这一问题,对于在校大学生和想提高竞争力的职场人士来说迫在眉睫。本书编者在章节设计上,逐渐从大学校园会话过渡到职场交际,由浅入深,结构合理,语言轻松、实用、便于掌握,而且在内容安排上有以下三大特点:

• 结合场景学句型, 身临其境活学活用

在长期的英语学习过程中,我们积累了很多句型、词汇,但为什么遇到具体情景,很难迅速反应出正确的英语表达方式呢?

长期死记硬背的学习方式,缺乏身临其境的口语训练,将大量曾经学习过的句型束之高阁,并没有成为自己的语言应用体系的有机组成部分。本书设计了四个校园日常话题和七个办公室日常交流话题,将经典常用句型与情景紧密结合,帮助学习者快速应对各种商务情景。

• 重点句型再次归纳总结, 英语口语有规可循

本书将每单元的会话常用句型在课后进行归纳总结与扩展, 读者需要扎实地掌握这些常用句型,并用于相应的情景会话训练, 会发现英语口语的学习并非难比登天,而是有规可循的。

•精心准备课后练习,巩固知识举一反三

学习后的及时复习是对抗遗忘的有效方法,本书每单元后配有情景对话、翻译、听力等同步练习,使读者能够及时巩固句型知识,并能运用到各种场景中,同时读者可以利用书中的情景对话和例句自己设计对话练习,即学即用,举一反三。

本书根据教育部最新发布的高职高专院校大学英语课程培养目标和要求而编写,可作为高职高专院校大学英语课程的口语训练补充材料。由于时间仓促,书中错误在所难免,恳请各院校师生批评指正。


