编者

前言

本书是卫生部组织的全国医学博士英语统一考试辅导丛书之一,在结合最新考试大纲和对最新真题分析的基础上进行了修订。

本书充分考虑了医学考博考生时间紧张、战线长、攻克考试难度大等特点,将 医学考博词汇按难易程度和考查范畴分为基础词汇、高频词汇、高级词汇和医学专 用词汇,便于考生根据自身的英语水平选择合适有效的复习策略。英语水平较好的 读者可以重点复习高频和高级词汇;医学专用词汇不适合背诵记忆,只是在考试复 习时便于术语的查找,同时也可成为工作中的好帮手。

本书打破了现在很多词汇书主次不清、难易不分、从 A-Z 直接从头到尾排列等编排方式,直接引导考生合理分配备考的时间和精力,考生可以得到更明确的指导,因此更具应试性。本书具有以下特点:

1. 科学测试,合理规划复习进度

各部分词汇测试成绩与复习建议对照表,对不同程度的考生给出不同的复习建议和策略。在基础词汇、高频词汇和核心词汇前各提供了一定数量的测试题,考生在学习词汇之前可先自我测试,根据测试成绩,参照本书提供的建议和策略,制订出自己的复习计划。高频词汇部分在开始部分特意提供了词汇复习8周分工计划,根据记忆特点科学规划,既方便考生快速记忆,还能作为快速自查复习效果的工具。

2. 等级分明,有效把握复习重点

正文划分为四个等级:基础词汇、高频词汇(一)、高频词汇(二)、高级词汇。高频词汇(一)是考试频率较高但较为简单的词汇,高频词汇(二)则是难度较大的高频词,更需要考生关注用法。本书对各部分重点词汇给出了经典例题和经典例句。另外,英语中有许多特殊用法、习惯搭配和重要语法等考点,本书在相关词条下设有【名师导学】栏目,虽寥寥数语,却能一针见血地解开许多考生百思不解的疑惑。【名师导学】栏目中增加了"近义词"内容,不仅便于考生扩大词汇量,同时直击考试中的词汇考题,迅速提分。基础词汇部分特意增加了2000个高中词汇一览表,以供考生快速浏览,查漏补缺。

本次修订还加上了"常见近义词词汇表",以便考生能从容应对词汇考题中近义词替换部分,同时还能帮助考生扩展词汇量。

3. 专业突出,科学掌握医学专用词汇

医学专业词汇在医学考博中至关重要,是考生不容忽视的一面。本书将医学



专业词汇进行了全面、完善的整理、归类和扩充。对常见单词的普通含义及医学含义进行了对比归类,便于考生尽快熟悉并掌握专业词汇,也可作为考生平时医护工作中理解医学英语时速查之用。

4. 记忆有方, 快速攻克词汇堡垒

本书词汇充分发挥【联想记忆】的功效,运用前后缀、联想记忆等方法,采 用以词带词的编排方式,让考生开阔视野,举一反三,成串记忆,横向扩充词汇 量。另外,本书还给出很多【巧记】方法,通俗易懂,生动形象,能够有效地帮 助考生快速记忆词汇。

因编者水平有限,错误之处在所难免,敬请同行和广大读者批评指正!
