本书是卫生部组织的全国医学博士英语统一考试辅导丛书之一，在结合最新考试大纲和对最新真题分析的基础上进行了修订。

本书充分考虑了医学考博考生时间紧张、战线长、攻克考试难度大等特点，将医学考博词汇按难易程度和考查范畴分为基础词汇、高频词汇、高级词汇和医学专用词汇，便于考生根据自身的英语水平选择合适有效的复习策略。英语水平较好的读者可以重点复习高频和高级词汇；医学专用词汇不适合背诵记忆，只是在考试复习时便于术语的查找，同时也可成为工作中的好帮手。

本书打破了现在很多词汇书主次不清、难易不分、从 A-Z 直接从头到尾排列等编排方式，直接引导考生合理分配备考的时间和精力，考生可以得到更明确的指导，因此更具应试性。本书具有以下特点：

### 1. 科学测试，合理规划复习进度

各部分词汇测试成绩与复习建议对照表，对不同程度的考生给出不同的复习建议和策略。在基础词汇、高频词汇和核心词汇前各提供了一定数量的测试题，考生在学习词汇之前可先自我测试，根据测试成绩，参照本书提供的建议和策略，制订出自己的复习计划。高频词汇部分在开始部分特意提供了词汇复习 8 周分工计划，根据记忆特点科学规划，既方便考生快速记忆，还能作为快速自查复习效果的工具。

### 2. 等级分明，有效把握复习重点

正文划分为四个等级：基础词汇、高频词汇（一）、高频词汇（二）、高级词汇。高频词汇（一）是考试频率较高但较为简单的词汇，高频词汇（二）则是难度较大的高频词，更需要考生关注用法。本书对各部分重点词汇给出了经典例题和经典例句。另外，英语中有许多特殊用法、习惯搭配和重要语法等考点，本书在相关词条下设有【名师导学】栏目，虽寥寥数语，却能一针见血地解开许多考生百思不解的疑惑。【名师导学】栏目中增加了“近义词”内容，不仅便于考生扩大词汇量，同时直击考试中的词汇考题，迅速提分。基础词汇部分特意增加了 2000 个高中词汇一览表，以供考生快速浏览，查漏补缺。

本次修订还加上了“常见近义词词汇表”，以便考生能从容应对词汇考题中近义词替换部分，同时还能帮助考生扩展词汇量。

### 3. 专业突出，科学掌握医学专用词汇

医学专业词汇在医学考博中至关重要，是考生不容忽视的一面。本书将医学

专业词汇进行了全面、完善的整理、归类和扩充。对常见单词的普通含义及医学含义进行了对比归类，便于考生尽快熟悉并掌握专业词汇，也可作为考生平时防护工作中理解医学英语时速查之用。

#### 4. 记忆有方，快速攻克词汇堡垒

本书词汇充分发挥【联想记忆】的功效，运用前后缀、联想记忆等方法，采用以词带词的编排方式，让考生开阔视野，举一反三，成串记忆，横向扩充词汇量。另外，本书还给出很多【巧记】方法，通俗易懂，生动形象，能够有效地帮助考生快速记忆词汇。

因编者水平有限，错误之处在所难免，敬请同行和广大读者批评指正！

复习提示: 1. 表中所指的一个周期指将该部分没有掌握的单词完整地复习一遍所用的时间。

- 在每个周期中, 将每天的单词分成 2~3 个时间段来记忆, 多次少量比一次多量的效果要好。并不断总结构词法, 将构词法知识运用在记单词中。
- 在每次记忆词汇的过程中, 一定要对不同程度单词做上不同的标记。在反复记忆的过程中, 一定要反复标记, 反复筛选陌生词汇。
- 每次在记忆新闻之前, 一定要浏览前一天已背的词汇。背单词不是简单的重复记忆, 同一个周期中, 应尽可能地充分利用零碎时间, 在不同的场景下反复记忆。
- 背单词的第一步, 最好是能够大声地朗读出来。同时也可以变换背单词的方式, 如在纸上写、造句、公交车上背、写邮件……随时保持记忆的新鲜感。
- 记忆新闻一定要理解其含义和用法, 认真研读经典例句和例句。每天的单词记忆一定要辅以大量的练习题, 在运用中掌握词汇。
- 本复习进度表是根据本书的结构特点, 结合测试学课题研究和多位英语教师自身多年的教学研究编制而成, 供广大读者参考, 不一定适合于所有读者。
