## 内容提要

英语中有许许多多意思相同、相近的词汇和短语。在这些同义、近义词语中,哪些在意思和用法上完全相同,可以互换?哪些在意思和用法上差别较大,不能互换?哪些又是差别微妙,需要细加分辨的?哪些在某些场合可以互换,而在另外一些场合却又不能?哪些意思虽然相同,但所要求的句型结构或搭配关系却又不同?如此等等。对于诸如此类的问题,本书不仅从意思、用法上予以简要、精确的说明,更注意提供丰富的实例,使读者掌握这些词汇的具体应用情景和用法。本书内容较新,紧跟时代步伐;辨析有的放矢,针对性强,因而极具实用性。

本书共收录常用英语同义、近义词 700 组,主要用于具有初、中级以及更高英语水平的读者,是各类应试答疑解惑的必备用书,同时也是英语自学、教学及翻译者不可缺少的工具书。

## ○前言

无论是中学生、大学生,还是硕士、博士研究生等更高层次的英语学习者,在英语学习中都不可避免地会遇到一个相当棘手的问题,那就是在英语语言中存在的数量众多的意思相同、相近的词汇和短语。这些同义、近义词语的存在,既给英语增辉添彩,避免枯燥、单调和乏味,也给英语学习者带来不少困难。本书编者在长期的大学英语教学过程中,发现同学们由于在这方面出错率居高不下,英语学习也往往事倍功半、举步不前,而国内出版市场又难以找到针对性较强的参考书和资料。有感于此,编者们根据自己多年的英语教学实践和英语学习的切身感受,结合学生在英语学习过程中较常出现的问题,以水滴石穿、集腋成裘的精神,历经数年寒暑,搜集、整理、精选出常用的700组英语同义、近义词汇和短语,付梓成书。

本书对于在英语学习和考试中的常见同义、近义词汇和短语,力图从意思和用法上予以简明扼要的辨析,并提供相应的实例,使读者能从具体应用的语境中感知体察其异同,进而达到准确理解,并恰当、得体、自如运用的目的。此外,本书还针对读者在使用过程中常出现、易出现和可能出现的错误,对这些词语常用的句型结构、搭配关系、使用场合等,做了适当说明。
