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内容提要

本教材旨在为学生提供原汁原味、兴趣度高的听说材料,听力活动涉及题材广泛,有广播、电视、讲座,陈述、辩论、对话等,听力任务真实,给学生营造了生动的语言学习环境。

全书分为上下两册,所选择的主题均为比较流行和为学生所熟悉的内容,包括学校,家庭、公共服务机构以及社会生活等。本书为上册,共 12 章,分别为 First Class、Health、Traffic、Shopping、Travel、Famous People、Telephone Message、Movie、Friendship、Food、Romance、Campus Life。

本书可作为本科院校公共英语听说教材,也可以作为英语专业听力专项教材。

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《英语视听说基础教程》(Tactics for Viewing, Listening and Speaking)主要"以输出为目标,以输入为驱动",将学生的语言输出和输入紧密 结合起来,同时接轨国外 ESL 听力教学研究成果,主张以说的输出带动 听的输入的提高,促进输入接受的积极性和效率,并摒弃纯粹的听力灌 输法。

教材的主题特色。全书分为上、下册,每册 12 个单元。本教材为学生提供原汁原味、兴趣盎然的听说材料,所选择的主题均为比较流行和学生所熟悉的内容,包括学校、家庭、公共服务机构以及社会生活等。这些听力活动旨在反映当今学生所面对的真实世界的听力特点。听力活动涉及题材广泛,有广播、电视、讲座,陈述、辩论、对话等,听力任务真实,给学生营造了生动的语言学习环境。

教材的组织特点。听力材料分成 24 个单元,每个单元聚焦不同的主题,每个单元的材料和活动均围绕同一个话题,注重趣味性和新颖性。每个单元提供三个梯度水平的听力任务,其目的是"循序渐进",并使得教师在教学中能根据教学对象有所取舍。编写的教材提供了一个涉及所有主题活动的概念框架图(Map of the book),便于授课教师能较快地为教授对象确定合适的听力任务。

教材的单元组织特点。每个单元分成三个阶段,第一阶段为预热听说(Warm up),目的是让学生集中到他们即将要听的主题上来;第二阶段为主要听力活动部分,主要让学生去听或视听一些材料,完成一些现实和真实的任务,并让学生有机会参与主题讨论,从而使得主题更加个性化。使用这个部分的材料时,可以不按照编排顺序,自由选择。第三阶段为经典英文歌曲填空或视频材料讨论,这部分内容充分考虑学生的兴趣,扩展了单元主题,寓教于乐。

教材的优势。本教材能避免学生在上课时被动地接受信息。当学生不能理解他们所听的内容时,常常感到沮丧,而本教材活动设计的目

的是帮助学生接受挑战,取得成功。为了减少学生在听的过程中对不熟悉的词汇的迷惑,本教材在听前为学生提供了听力材料的关键词汇和表达方式。教材所采用的大量真实语境材料可以较好地联系学生的真实世界经验,使学生意识到当前听力活动的价值,并更加积极地参与其中。另外我们在试题编写过程中也结合了一些国外雅思、托福听力考试的主观题型特点,注重培养学生的理解、归纳、推断等综合语言能力。

《英语视听说基础教程》一书由何琼主编,冯绵、白陈英担任《英语视听说基础教程》(上)副主编;白陈英、龙明慧担任《英语视听说基础教程》(下)副主编(此部分排名不分先后,以姓氏笔画为序)。何琼、冯锦、白陈英、龙明慧、陈艳君、Becky Ances 等老师参与编写。本书在编写时得到了浙江农林大学的大力支持,并参考了国内外一些优秀的教材,在此一并表示感谢!

由于时间仓促,编著水平和经验有限,书中难免有疏漏和不足之处, 恳请广大读者批评指正!


