## 前　　言

英国文化注重个性、特殊性，强调差异，对于同一事物、同一概念人们往往习惯于采用多种不同的词汇进行表达，造成了英语中大量近义词的存在。这些不同的表达之间通常或多或少地存在着些差异，这些差异给英语学习者，特别是中国英语学习者带来了极大的困惑和障碍。中英文化迥异，体现在词汇的使用上差异更加突出，中国文化更注重原则、注重统一，强调集中，因此对中国学习者而言，学好英语近义词确实不易。

在我国，学者们对英语近义词的研究兴趣一直没有减弱，但他们大都采用传统的近义词研究方法，主要借助于词典上的定义、翻译和例句对近义词进行辨析。这种研究方法，往往效率低、效果差，而且研究所用语言材料大多并非基于真实的语料。因此，结论不能令人信服。如在辨析 *inner* 与 *interior, internal, inward* 的异同点时，国内一本权威的近义词词典进行了如下描述：“*inner* 与 *inward* 相近，都有空间和比喻的两种用法，用于空间时，指比较靠里接近中心，*inward* 指方向朝里。比喻的用法两词都指内心深处隐藏秘密的。”但是，对英国国家语料库（BNC）的调查显示，*inner* 还被频繁地用于修饰 *circle, cabinet* 等名词，表示“核心成员的，或核心集团的”，而这一用法是本组其他词都没有的。

基于语料库的近义词研究，采用实证性研究方法，克服了以往通过抽象说明和描述辨析近义词的弊端，利于更客观地揭示近义词在实际生活中的使用情况。语料库具有容量大、语料真实、检索快捷等独特的优势，因此，基于语料库的近义词研究，能为学习者提供有关近义词在使用频率、搭配、语法结构等方面的大量有用信息。

和学习资料，帮助学习者增加相关的语言输入量，促使他们更客观、更全面地认识目标近义词，掌握它们的使用规律。

当然在过去的十年中，也出现了部分基于语料库的近义词研究，但这些研究基本上都只限于对个别近义词组进行研究，对大学常见近义词进行基于语料库的、较为系统的研究在我国至今仍未很好地开展。笔者从事英语教育工作二十余年，从事语料库语言学研究工作十余年，非常愿意将自己在该领域所作的一些探索和研究成果与国内同行和英语学习者分享，借以推动语料库在我国英语教学中的广泛运用和深入发展。

本书对 250 组大学阶段常见的易混英语近义词开展了基于语料库的研究，涉及词语近千个。研究所用语料均出自权威的英国国家语料库（BNC），该语料库约含 1 亿字词，其中书面语子库约 9000 万词，口语子库约 1000 万词。对各组近义词的研究主要涉及使用频率、语义、搭配及语法模式等方面的内容。

本书具有以下特点：

(1) 提供了研究所涉及的各近义词的标准使用频率，即每百万字中的使用频率，供学习者对比、参考。如果目标词汇具有不同的词性，如 elastic, resilient, flexible, supple 这组形容词近义词词组中的 elastic，既可作名词，也可作形容词，那么在计算该词的标准频率时，作者将它作名词的频率去除掉，仅计算其作形容词时的标准频率，以便与本组其他形容词进行更为科学的比较。

(2) 既指出了各近义词组所包含的共同语义，也剖析了各词语所具有的特殊内涵。

(3) 列举了各近义词的部分常见搭配词及这些搭配词在 BNC 中与目标近义词的搭配频率，以帮助学习者大体了解所列搭配词的典型程度。如常见的被 lawful 修饰的名词有：authority (48)/visit (28)/holder (7)/wife (6)/heir (6)/user (5) 等，括号中的数字表示在 BNC 中这些名词搭配词被 lawful 修饰的频数。

(4) 依据语料库调查结果，给出了各近义词的常用语法结构，便于学习者从语法结构层面上更好地把握各近义词。

(5) 提供了从语料库中提取的各近义词的索引行实例，使学习者能接触、了解这些词在现实生活中的实际使用方法。

本书适合大学在校生，准备参加四、六级考试，研究生考试，雅思考试，托福考试的考生，以及英语教师和广大英语爱好者使用。

本书的写作得益于老师、领导、同事和家人的帮助和支持。特别感谢苏州大学博士生导师严世清教授的悉心指导和关心，感谢苏州健雄职业技术学院的大力支持。写作过程中参阅了大量国内外学者的研究成果，研究过程中使用了 Wordsmith 5.0, Sketch Engine 等语料库文本分析软件，在此对相关学者、语料库和软件研发者致以衷心的感谢。

本书是江苏省社科应用研究精品工程外语类课题“基于语料库的大学常见英语近义词研究”（编号 14jsyw - 36）的主要研究成果。

基于语料库的实证性近义词研究在我国起步晚、研究范围小、成果少，本书呈现的是作者在该领域的一些探索性研究成果。作者深知本书所研究的近义词词组在数量上还不够丰富，在对语料的分析、归纳和总结上还不够深刻和完善，诚恳地希望广大读者和同行对书中存在的疏漏之处提出批评和指正，以便修订时改正。
