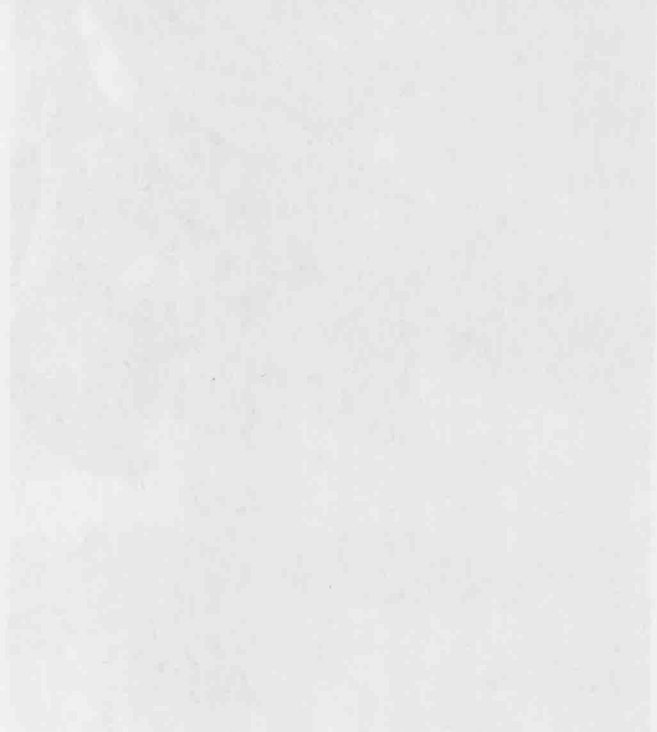

重点解析

“名词 + 现在分词”的复合形容词

本文中出现的 **mind-blowing** 为“名词 + 现在分词”所组成的复合形容词, 此类结构的形容词一律由主动语态的定语从句简化而成, 其规则如下:

1. 主动语态的定语从句

That is a ride which is said to **stop** people's hearts.
(那个娱乐设施据说能使人心跳暂停。)

上列例句中, **which is said to stop people's hearts** 是定语从句, 及物动词 **stop** 后有宾语 **hearts**, 属主动语态。

2. 将主动语态的定语从句变成复合形容词

a. 找出作宾语的名词, 并将该名词一律变作单数, 之后置入连字符号。

b. 将宾语前的及物动词变成现在分词, 加上连字符号后, 所形成的复合形容词置于先行词之前, 故上句亦可改写如下:

In the game, players try to create words on a virtual³ board, and they get points for the letters they use. Each new word must be connected to one that has already been played by at least one letter. Like most of the best games out there, Words With Friends is simple and **straightforward**.

Words With Friends is really **taking off**. The game has been attracting extra attention since it is quite popular with celebrities. Robert Pattinson from the *Twilight*⁴ movies mentioned his love for the game in a recent interview. Alec Baldwin, star of the hit⁵ TV series *30 Rock*, was recently **kicked off** a plane when he **refused to** stop playing Words With Friends on his iPad. The app also has a chat **function**, so you and your opponent can communicate between moves. For two US residents, this led to true love. They played and chatted during a few games and **ended up** getting married. Now that shows the power of words!
