The food is delicious. Everyone likes the doughnuts.



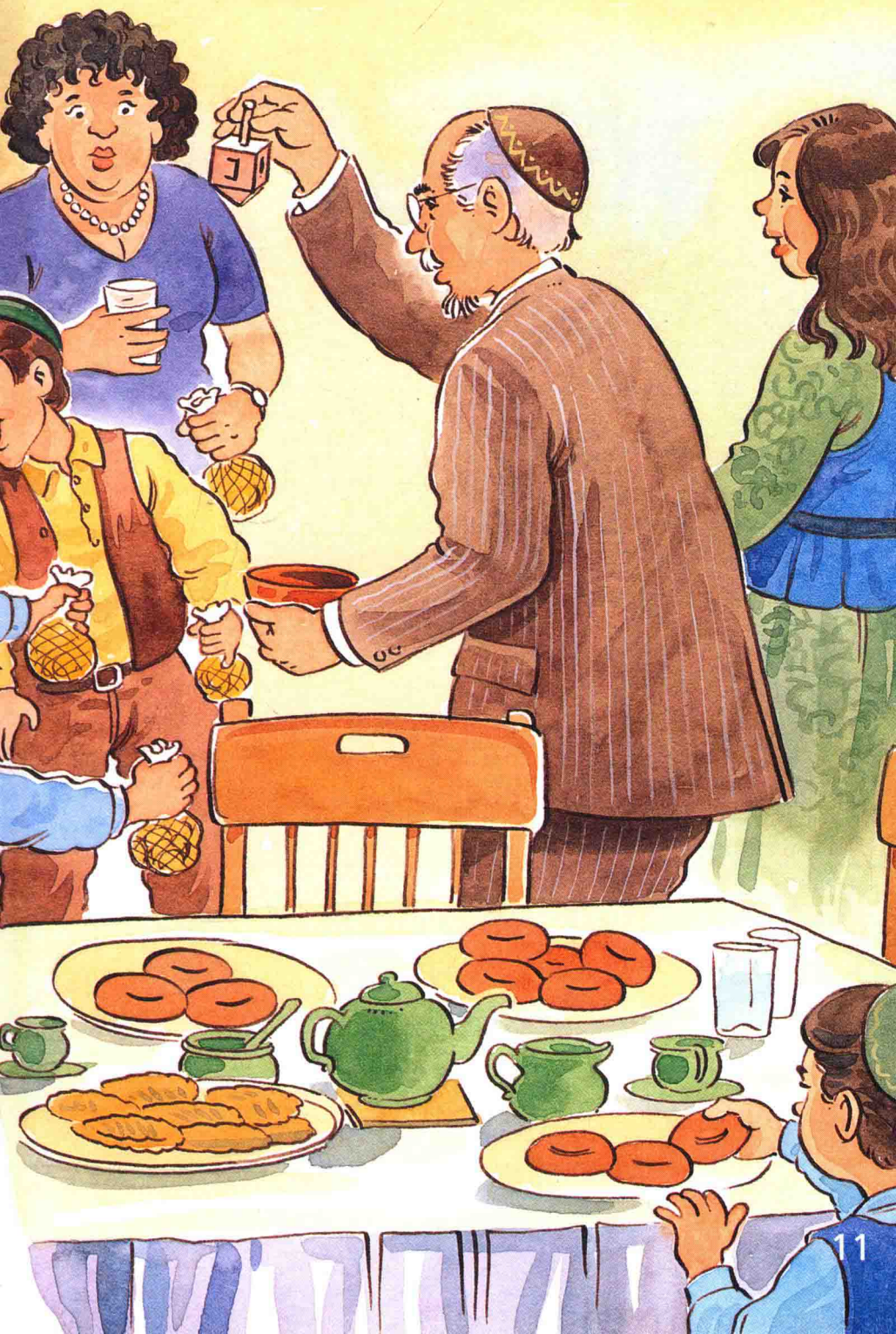
At last it is time for the presents. Sarah likes her cute little bear. I open my presents. I have a beautiful ring and a book... and a little bear just like Sarah's.
