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致读者

在英语学习中，由于常常重视听、说、读等能力的训练，而忽略书写技能的训练，导致了很多英语学习者其他方面的水平日益提高，书写水平却每况愈下，毫无美感可言；更有甚者，因卷面书写潦草不清而失分。很多教学专家认为，在学习语言之初就应该培养良好的书写习惯，掌握正确的书写方法，所以“写一手好字”已不再是选择性需求，而是必备的基础技能。

基于以上原因，我们为广大家零起点英语书写学习群体编写了这样一套字帖，共9本。在编写时，根据学习群体的分布特点我们精心选取了使用非常广泛的3种字体，即简洁的手写印刷体、流畅的斜体和优雅的圆体。其中，手写印刷体适合学龄前儿童及小学生群体练习使用，而斜体和圆体则适合中学生和成人群体练习使用。而且3种字体都分别配有基础入门分册、进阶分册、提高分册，目的就是为了让读者按照由易到难的学习方法，系统有效地逐步掌握3种字体的书写方法。书中没有长篇累牍的抽象理论，而是用最简单直接的语言阐明要点，然后辅助大量练习，让读者用最短的时间、最高效的方法写出一手漂亮潇洒的英文。值得一提的是，本系列丛书采用直接描红法和临帖法，使书写更具真实感，便于掌握笔法笔意，从而学到优美字体的精髓。

手写印刷体进阶分册的内容着重于句子书写练习，本书内容分为两部分。第一部分是常用句集锦，分为问候招呼、相互介绍、感谢道歉、天气情况、电话交流、饭店就餐、逛街购物、问路指路、生病就医9个场景，使读者在提高英文书写能力的同时轻松掌握口语交际中的基本句型。第二部分是名人语录，在练习长句书写的同时帮助读者积累语言学习的素材。

写出一手好字，并非一日之功。读者在练习时切忌心浮气躁，急于求成，应该一笔一划认真学习，打好基础，先写好，再写快。愿本书能为广大读者提高英文书写水平助一臂之力，相信您一定可以成为人人称赞的“书法家”。

文化常识

由于语言文化和风俗习惯的不同，不同国家的人们表达问候的形式并不一致，有的可能相去甚远。比如中国人早上见面时说“你(您)早”，可英美人说“Good morning”。这两种问候语看似没什么差别，其实不然。汉语中，“你早”的意思是“你起来得早”，“Good morning”表示一种祝福，二者含义不同。此外，在问候时，英美人经常会说“How are you”“Glad to meet you”等。而汉语习惯讲的“您去哪”“上街呀”“吃了没”如果直译成“Where are you going”“Have you had your meal”，英美人很可能误会你要限制他们的自由或你要请他们吃饭。

感恩节的故事
