前 言

《高等学校英语应用能力考试听力真题与模拟训练(2000~2009)》是高等学校英语应用能力考试技巧训练系列教材之一。该书是以《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》为指南,针对高职学生英语听力能力相对偏弱的问题,按照教育部颁布的《高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲》而编写的一本具有实战演练性质的考前听力训练复习指导书。全书分为上篇、中篇和下篇三个部分。上篇包括高等学校英语应用能力考试(A、B级)听力真题汇编,中篇包括高等学校英语应用能力考试(A、B级)听力模拟试题,下篇包括高等学校英语应用能力考试听力材料与答案解析。本书适用于国内大学专科、高职高专学生参加全国英语应用能力考试(PRETCO)使用。

本书编写具有如下特点:

一、听力试题编写体现实用性

本书汇总搜集了2000年6月至2009年6月英语应用能力考试(A、B级)听力真题。其中A级听力真题19套,B级听力真题19套,每套试题均附听力原稿、答案和解析。内容详尽,解析简明,并有中文翻译,便于学生复习使用。学生通过历年考试真题集中训练听力,可提高英语听力考试的应试技巧和应试能力。

二、听力内容编写突出地方特色

本书听力模拟试题结合《新编实用英语综合教程》(天津版)相关主题内容编写,内容体现主题性,突出天津特色。编写体例、难易程度与高等学校英语应用能力考试真题一致。模拟试题共20套,其中A级模拟试题10套,B级模拟试题10套。每套模拟试题都配有听力原稿、答案和解析。

三、听力试题编写体现针对性

本书旨在通过训练逐步提高在校高职学生英语听力能力,为高职学生参加全国英语应用能力考试(A、B级)提供必要的保障。

本书在编写过程中得到天津职业大学曹玉泉教授的热情帮助和指导,在此一并致谢。
