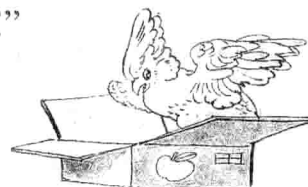
"I picked the most apples," said Li Lei.

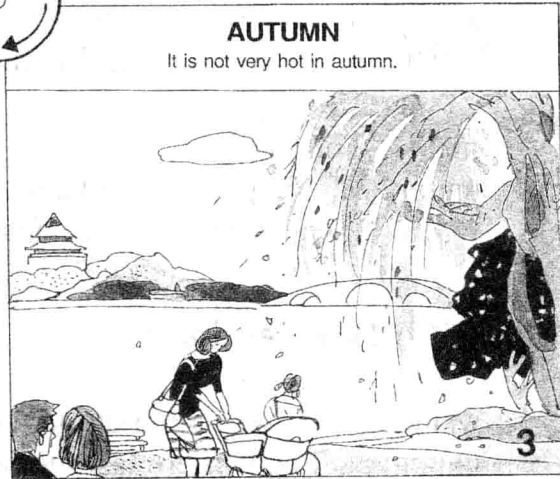
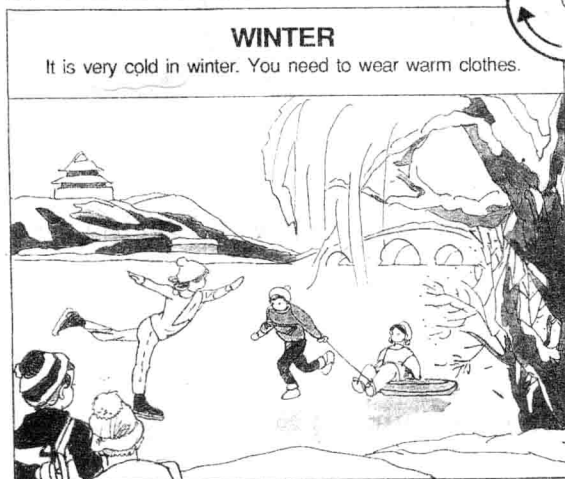
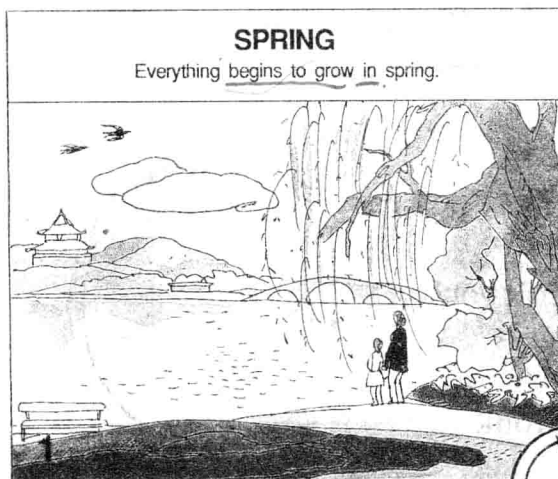
