




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#### 内容提要

Do you live in a house or an apartment?

Candidate:

I live in an apartment ... um ... that apartment locate at a ... um ... north road. It very close to a park so the view is wonderful there.

Examiner:

Do you like your home?

Candidate:

Yeah, I like my home very much.

Examiner:

Why?

Candidate:

Because only if you stay at home, you get so so fun where you belong to. And you have this relaxing, that feeling and make you feel that you like it. Okay.

#### Examiner:

What are advantages and disadvantages of living alone?

#### Candidate:

The biggest advantage I'd like to put it first is the traffic, because as you know Beijing is busy traffic hour. Traffic can turn very, very bad. So I have to wait hours and hours to get a taxi if I want to go to somewhere. And that's the biggest disadvantage for leaving in town. But the biggest advantage they can have is very convenient for you to go to other parts of the city. And ... the metro, the subway is very convenient and links everywhere if you want to go.

#### Examiner:

Let's talk about languages. How many different languages do you speak? Candidate:

I speak English for sure but I also speak a bit of French because English is my first major in university, and we have to ... have to speak a secondary language ... as ... since we start ... pick up English as our first language. So I speak a little bit French, a little bit Thailand ... a little bit Thai because I travelled a lot to Thailand.

#### Examiner:

Is it important do you think to speak languages?

#### Candidate.

O ... Kay. Language is very important in terms of communication, and it makes people from different cultures to understand you easily. So it provides all access to the ...

um ... for example, you go to a different culture and you have been able to speak the local languages, all the things you want to do is much easier ... yeah ... you know ... you can communicate. It's the most important thing.

#### Examiner:

What's the most effective way to learn new languages?

#### Candidate:

I think the most effective way to learn new language is to put yourself in the culture first that you have to be able to understand the way people to think and try to imitate the ... imitate the tones and other gestures ... yeah ... try to localization is idea that is very important in terms of learning new languages.

The work is very delicate and there is a very beautiful picture, a picture in there. I think I use the word "behind this wall", sorry. Behind this wall, there is this meeting hall, when I was studying in this high school.

Candidate:

Yes.

Examiner:

Okay.

Candidate:

Who are you living with.

Examiner:

Why?

Candidate:

Because building is all the same, department is all the same, decoration is not a big thing. But the people you are living with I think is the core of a family.

Examiner:

Do you mean the family or do you mean the neighbors as well?

Candidate:

Just the family.

Examiner:

Neighbors?

Candidate:

They matter, but not as important as my family.

#### Examiner:

Have you imagined your home would be different ten years in the future compared to now?

#### Candidate:

Just homes. There would be more Hi-tech things. One of my friends, he went to Paris months ago and he told us plenty of automatic curtain that you are remote it with air remoter. It is something going to have in every house in the recent years.

#### Examiner:

Do you think it's a good thing?

#### Candidate:

Somehow it's a good thing. It get people become lazier, but also make our life more convenient.

#### Examiner:

Is convenience for a home an important priority for a lot of people?

#### Candidate:

I don't know a lot of people, but for me, being convenient is important.

#### Examiner:

Let's move on to people who do not have homes. Many people in the world are homeless, including people in China. Do you think homeless people are basically responsible for their own situation?

#### Candidate:

Partly. But I think they are like in the higher level, they are ... they should be responsible for their government, the whole society.

#### Examiner:

You think the government should take care of them? How should they take care of them? Candidate:

She ... Shelter them, build shelters for them and try to find them jobs.

#### Examiner:

Do you think in China especially homelessness is a byproduct of the rapid economic

growth?

Candidate:

Um ... I don't really think so. I think there are many reasons for the so-called "Chinese Miracle", but I don't think they are one of there, the sacrifice of the reasons of the rapid development. No.
