### 编者的话

中国邮轮产业自从 2006 年发端以来,一直保持迅猛的发展态势。邮轮旅游业首先从上海起步,逐步在各大沿海城市兴起,现正朝内陆城市渗透发展。刚刚过去的 2016 年,已经有超过二百万人次的中国游客乘坐邮轮出游,中国已经成为国际邮轮产业发展的新重点。国际邮轮公司不断派新船来华,皇家加勒比亚洲培训中心已经落户天津,挪威邮轮公司 2017 年正式在华开展邮轮旅游业务,中船集团和嘉年华集团签署战略合作协议,中国开始自己建造豪华邮轮,这些都说明邮轮产业在我国是一个真真正正的朝阳产业。当然,中国邮轮产业起步较晚,还有很多问题。比如:产业链不完整,中国邮轮产业集中于游客接待、邮轮停靠等低端产业链环节,中国企业还无法进行豪华邮轮设计建造,高端产业链环节仍然空白,中国邮轮母港对经济的辐射拉动作用还很不明显,邮轮专业人才培养能力十分不足等。

锦航集团始建于2004年,旗下拥有天津锦航远洋企业管理有限公司、河北锦航船舶技术服务有限公司、天津艾维创科技有限公司等多家企业。其中河北锦航船舶技术服务有限公司为国家海事局批准的甲级船员服务机构,获得ISO9001-2008质量管理体系证书,为河北省船员服务行业协会常务理事单位。锦航集团乘着邮轮产业大发展的东风,"校企合作"工作稳步推进,业务逐年增加,出版一套具有邮轮特点的英语培训教材已十分必要。鉴于此,公司集多年的"校企合作订单培养"教学经验,吸纳国内外邮轮英语教学内容,并争取国际邮轮管理同仁的意见和建议,出版了这本具有邮轮特色的《国际邮轮乘务英语》。

本书主要包含三个部分。第一部分是邮轮基础知识,主要介绍邮轮的发展简况、邮轮航线、邮轮旅游等内容。由于本节主要面向职业院校,所以没有长篇累牍地介绍邮轮专业知识,而是就一些实用性内容进行介绍。第二部分是邮轮乘务岗位实用英语,主要介绍了客房、餐厅、吧台、博彩、免税店、娱乐、前台等服务内容,并介绍了各个部门的岗位名称和岗位职责。第三部分是附录,介绍了航行在世界上的邮轮的名称、世界著名的邮轮公司和邮轮港口,以及邮轮服务常用词汇。此外,本书还附有中文译文和听力练习的答案。

Mr. Smart: It is so knowledgeable of you to know that one cruise ship berthed in Shanghai in 2006. It is the first time that the cruise ship has berthed in China. From that time, Chinese people began to know the cruise ship.

Student: What is the name of that ship?

Mr. Smart: It is called Costa Allegra.

Student: Thanks. But you still did not tell me what a cruise ship is.

Mr. Smart: A cruise ship is a kind of ship that transports passengers from place to place for pleasure. Different from ordinary ships, on the cruise ship, there are many facilities, such as restaurants, bars, shopping centers, gyms, entertainment venues, communication centers and so on. #### ► Passage 1

In the past days, the main means of transporting troops to the war zone was by ship. In major wars, these were often cruise ships. Two cruise ships, called Queen Mary and Queen Elizabeth, were used to carry troops in the World War II in one year, because of the extensive troop lift they provided from North America to Europe. The extreme use of troop ships in both world wars gave rise to the construction of a fleet of cruise ships. When submarines that could achieve 40 knots and more under water were constructed, the concept of placing thousands of troops on these cruise ships in hostile waters became too dangerous. Thus cruise ships were seldom used in military aspects. So today cruise ships are regarded as moving resorts gradually. But some day when a new war begin, what will cruise ships be used at that time?

#### ► Passage 2

When we are learning the cruise ships, we need to know some terms about the cruise ship.

Boutique ship is a small but very luxurious all-suite cruise ship. The two earliest such ships were Sea Goddess I and Sea Goddess II. The Sea Goddess ships are of 4,620 tons carrying a maximum of 116 passengers in luxurious accommodations. This kind of ship has been more notable for high standards of accommodation than for profitability.

**Combi vessel** often refers to a passenger-cargo ship, which is a vessel that carries more than 12 passengers in addition to cargoes.

**Grand dame** is a reference to older vessels, frequently former ocean liners. The best example of this is the former Holland America vessel Rotterdam.

Theme cruise is a cruise where some or all onboard activities are intended to attract people with a special theme. This has been used by many companies to fill ships during fringe seasons. Norwegian Cruise Liner (NCL) has been very successful with its sports theme. One of the more exotic theme cruises is the music cruise (Le Festival de Musique en Mer). The cruise staff are sent on leave and their place are taken by musicians and those who manage events centered on classical music.

**Transcanal cruise** is generally used to denote cruise that provides a complete transit of the Panama Canal in either direction. These cruises are popular in North American and provide a great deal of revenue both as cruise series and as positioning cruises between West Coast and positio-

ning cruises between West Coast and Caribbean cruise areas.
