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# 序言

Fig. Preface

TOEFL 全名为 "Test of English as a Foreign Language",是由美国教育考试服务中心(ETS)研发推广的英语能力测试,中文音译为"托福"。托福所提供的语言成绩不仅可以帮助考生申请美国高等院校,也可以成为考生正确学习英语的指南。

目前,托福考试以互联网为依托进行机考,称为 iBT (internet-Based Test),其整体设计旨在评估考生在英语听、说、读、写技能方面的综合能力。词汇是托福考试中的基本单元,是托福备考的重中之重。近几年,随着托福考试的整体难度逐渐增加,考生们需要在备考过程中打下坚实的词汇基础,才不至于在托福的听、说、读、写四项测试中遇到障碍。因此,对于托福考试词汇资料的需求也亟待满足。

"直通托福"系列词汇书包含《直通托福·校园生活词汇》和《直通托福·课堂学术词汇》。 两本词汇书来源于应用语言学专家 Charles Browne 博士、Brent Culligan 博士及 Joseph Phillips 所编纂的 "新通用高频词表" (New General Service List)及 "新学术词汇词表" (New Academic Word List)。这两个词表是学术界广为认可的词汇学习词表,是从庞大的剑桥英语语料库中筛选出的高频和通用词汇。根据语言学专家统计,"新通用高频词表" 大致可以覆盖 86% 的学术背景文章;在这一基础之上,增加"新学术词汇词表",可以覆盖到 92% 左右的学术文章。对考生而言,在有限的备考时间中,学习这两个词表是极为便捷与高效的。

基于这两个权威词表,新东方美国本科考试研究院联合一线托福教师为每个词汇提供了托福考试场景下的例句,并设计具有相应难度的习题,帮助考生认知、理解及掌握单词。《直通托福·校园生活词汇》涵盖较为基础、高频的词汇,适合基础较为薄弱的考生;《直通托福·课堂学术词汇》涵盖学术文章、语料下的学科背景词汇,适合有一定词汇基础的考生。

本书为《直通托福·课堂学术词汇》,来源于"新学术词汇词表",大致涵盖 960 词,全书分为 16 个词汇单元,每个单元约有 60 个词汇。同时,每个单元匹配了三种难度的题型,帮助考生更为全面地掌握词汇。

- 1. 词表设计。所选词汇配合《牛津高阶辞典》中的音标及外教录制音频,帮助考生掌握单词的正确发音。同时配有托福考试中常见的词性及释义,选取 Merriam-Webster 中的简易英文释义,使考生更好地理解单词的含义。例句由一线教师从真题中挑选句子进行改写,最大程度上贴合托福真实考试场景。
- 2. 练习设置。每一个单元都匹配了三种类型的练习:填空(Fill in the Blanks)、配对 (Matching) 及搭配练习 (Collocations),涵盖了本单元中的所有单词。练习难度层层递进,希望考生能够从形态 (form)、释义 (meaning)、用法 (usage) 三个维度来掌握单词。词汇的学习过程中应有大量的重复,才能更好地巩固记忆,所以在填空及配对练习的题目设置中,选取了词表中的例句及简易英文释义,帮助考生理解、掌握单词的释义以及在例句中的应用。

第一部分练习为填空, 涉及词汇变形, 帮助考生了解单词的形态 (form)。

第二部分练习为配对,需要考生将单词与英文释义联系起来,帮助考生更加深入地理解单词的含义 (meaning)。

第三部分为搭配练习,由外教精心挑选词表中的常见单词,设置单词的搭配练习,帮助考生掌握单词的用法(usage),积累语料。

3. 书中所有习题均附有答案。第三部分搭配练习除标准答案之外,同时给出常见的其他搭配,辅助考生学习。

祝愿所有考生在本书的帮助下都能够顺利地通过 TOEFL 考试。
