Niagara Falls (waterfall) is located on the Niagara River in western New York and south eastern Ontario. It was formed about 12 000 years ago. Niagara Falls consists of the Horseshoe or Canadian Falls and the American Falls. The American Falls are separated (隔 开) by Goat Island, New York. A small section of the American Falls near Goat Island is also known as Bridalveil Falls.

The Niagara's large volume of flow, averaging about 5 520 cubic metres per second, plus its steep drop, give the river great power potential (势能). Horseshoe Falls carries about nine times more water than the U. S. Falls.

In 1958, the Canadians built a power station at Queenston, Ontario. And the Americans built one in 1963, on the United States side. Niagara Falls is a great tourist attraction, attracting millions of visitors each year. The falls may be viewed from parks located on either side of the river, from observation towers, from boats, from Goat Island. Visitors also may enter the Cave (洞) of the Winds, located behind a curtain (帘) of falling water near the base of the American Falls.

Hospitals in the United States are classified (分类) by the services they provide (general or specialized), the length of stay they offer patients (short stay or long-term care), and by their ownership (not-for-profit, proprietary (个体), or government owned). Although most U. S. hospitals are classified as not-for-profit, any one hospital will fall into several of the above parts. For example, Methodist Hospital in Houston, Texas, is one of the largest short-stay, not-for-profit, general hospitals in the country.

General hospitals provide patients with a wide range of services, including emergency treatment, surgery (外科), and medical and nursing care. Specialized hospitals, in contrast, may concentrate on a particular group of patients, such as children, or a disease, such as cancer. Some specialized hospitals combine treatment and research.

The American Hospital Association (AHA), classifies hospitals by the length of stay they offer patients. AHA classifies hospitals as short-stay care centers if their patients receive 30 days or less of inpatient (住院病人) treatment. In contrast, AHA classifies

hospitals as long-term care centers if their patients more than 30 days of treatment.

Not-for-profit hospitals represent about 84 percent of the hospitals in the United States. Although not-for-profit hospitals do not receive funding from tax contributors, they are freed from local, state, and federal taxation. Cities, counties, states, and the federal government also own hospitals. About 1 000 public hospitals are owned by their cities or counties and are supported by local tax dollars.
