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很多同学在备考 GRE 期间,最头疼的问题往往就是复杂繁多的词汇。2013 年,韩老师和我在实际教学过程中发现,同学们经常反映手里词汇资料词条多则七干有余,记忆负担沉重;少则在实际考试中复现率低,背诵性价比不高。我们在想,为何不基于每场考试的真实考情,整理一份真正针对现行 GRE 考试的词汇书呢?于是《GRE 高频真词表》(以下简称"佛脚词汇")计划应运而生。

相信刚走出考场的同学,对于本次考试里那些晦涩难懂的词汇一定记忆犹新,佛脚词汇表希望能够展示那些真正在考试中有价值的词汇。经过 2013~2014 年的积累,佛脚词汇初版词表共整理全年难词 1163 个,并有针对性地给出了同义词词对 274 对,让大家在解答相关题目时更加游刃有余。我们将初版词汇表汇总成 PDF,于网上免费公开,当时的定位是同学们考前两个月必备的高性价比词汇材料。与此同时,恰逢北京新东方学校的圣诞班与寒假班,经过线下与线上成百上千名同学的集体试用,大家在肯定之余,也给出了诸多宝贵的改进意见,这坚定了我们打磨完善佛脚词汇表的信心。

2013~2017 年收集记录难词从未间断,我们免费制作了 2.0~6.0 版本,并于每个季度推出,词汇数目增加 1700 个,同义词词对增加至 550 对。此时,我们已经发现,每次有效收集整理的难词数明显减少,从同学们的实际反馈也看出,佛脚词汇相较于手中其他资料,词汇复现率更高。为了使词汇书针对性更强,我们决定在原有的佛脚词库基础上,整理加入常考短语与阅读题目中的难词,最终收录主词 2400 余个,同义词词对850 余对。

这是一本经历了多个网络公开版才得以浓缩出来的词汇材料。至此,我们不妨总结 一下本书都有哪些优势:

- 从 GRE 改革以来积累至今,选择真正意义上可能的 GRE 重点词汇,剔除无意义的词汇,切实反映词汇考点动向。
- 特别添加常考"六选二"同义词词对、美国当代英语语料库(Corpus of Contemporary American English)主词词频、常考反义词、派生词、外教原创例句, 多维度诠释词汇。
- 英文释义参考韦氏词典与美国传统词典,中文释义力图忠实于语境。

佛脚词汇蕴含着一种和 GRE 战斗的精神,代表着我们竭尽全力减轻大家考试负担的同时,又保证和考试高度统一的不懈追求,也是我们六年多来教学与实战经验的浓缩。我们当然不会就此满足,GRE 佛脚词汇将继续不断地迭代更新下去。在此,诚挚感谢读者们的积极反馈,以及北京新东方程黛苑老师与武汉新东方冷楠老师的诸多宝贵意见与建议。


• 使用说明

本书主要分为两大部分: 主词表部分与短语表部分

在主词表部分中,每个标签的意义为下:

本书所收录的所有词汇都属于近些年考过的高频单词。为了让读者更加深刻地理解词汇在实际中的运用,我们参考了美国当代英语语料库(Corpus of Contemporary American English)中主词条出现的频率,由低到高将词频分为 1~5 五个等级,供读者参考。

单词的中英文释义。每个词的释义,并不是机械地搬运词典释义,而是结合具体考点语境做出对应的解释。英文释义从《韦氏大学词典》(Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary)simple definition或 full definition当中选择性摘录,同时也参考了美国传统词典(American Heritage Dictionary)的释义。



在 GRE 考试中,有一种题型叫做句子等价(sentence equivalence),俗称"六选二"。其中绝大多数情况下是要求考生选择一对同义词,使句子的逻辑变得通顺。基于实际考试,我们将考过的六选二词对予以标明,使所背即考点,性价比更高。

注意: (1) 有的时候两个词在原考题语境中是一对正确选项(比如说 inferable from 与 entailed by) 抛离了语境可能不是一对同义词,会使读者产生困惑,不用纠结,做到面熟即可。

(2) 有的时候"选"标签下给出的词汇的词性可能与主词词性不一致,不用在意。比如说 precocious 这个词给出的"选"为 maturity,是因为在考试中考的是 precocious 的名词词性,而陪考的同义词也为名词词性。此类现象,并非笔误,请读者理解。

由资深外教逐条编写的原创例 句,从英语母语者角度诠释一个词在语境中的具体运用。

我们希望考生能够做到举一反三,记忆一个词的同时能够将一系列的词都记住,所以也罗列了部分词汇的 常考派生词,旨在提高背诵记忆的性价比。
