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说到“英文短语”，许多人望而怯步的理由不外乎“单词都背不完，我哪有空去学短语？”“短语听起来很难，平常应该不会用到吧？”“考试会考单词、语法、句型、翻译，很少听到考查短语。”这些理由我也常听到辅导班的学生说，但被我教过的学生最后都会知道，原来这几个理由根本不构成理由！怎么说？就让我借这本书来和大家解释一下吧。

第一个错误观念 单词都背不完，我哪有空去学短语？

确实，大家都很忙，多学一点就多辛苦一点，我完全能理解。可是你知道吗？其实在英语作为母语人士的日常生活中，使用短语的机率很高，有很多短语的意思跟词面上看起来的完全不一样。举个简单的例子：take part in 中的 take 和 in 大家都应该认识，part 是“部分”的意思。可是 take part in 这个短语的意思却是“参加”，也就是说就算你知道 take、part 和 in 的意思，你还是一样看不懂这个短语！既然学了单词却不学短语会造成这么多的误解，那就算再没空也得学点短语，不然很多单词对你来说等于白学了！

第二个错误观念 短语听起来很难，平常应该不会用到吧？

这可不见得！英文短语并非俚语、谚语、成语，就算是 get up、fall asleep 这种两个连在一起的单词，也一样都是短语哦！所以绝对会经常用到。而且更奇妙的是，短语虽然词数可能多一点，但有时候反而比单词还更好记、更容易表达意思。举例来说，take part in 有三个单词，感觉好多，可是，如果要用一个单词表示这个意思，那你就得说 participate，看到这个单词那么长，大家应该都会觉得学 take part in 简单些吧。

第三个错误观念 考试会考单词、语法、句型、翻译，很少听到考查短语。

考试真的是会考短语的，这本书就为你验证！当然，考试或许不见得会直接考“请回答这个短语的意思”，但是在阅读理解等题型里面，都会出现很多短语！甚至有可能一篇文章有三分之一都是短语！而且有些短语在整个句子中还扮演了关键的角色，也就是说如果看不懂这个短语，就会误解整个句子的意思，然后题目就跟着答错了。要是不懂短语，就算掌握再多单词、语法、句型，还是有可能因为搞不清楚短语意思而白白失分。

大家现在应该跃跃欲试想进入短语的世界了吧？在本书中我对常用常考的短语特别进行了分析，相信对想学短语的你们能有一定程度的帮助。大家一起加油，搞定曾让你望而怯步的短语吧！

In English-speaking cultures, the choice of first names for children can be prompted by many factors: tradition, religion, nature, culture, and fashion, to name just a few. Certain people like to give a name that has been handed down in the family to show respect for or to remember a relative whom they love or admire. Some families have a tradition of giving the father's first name to the first-born son. In other families, a surname is included in the selection of a child's given name to show a family surname going. It may be the mother's maiden name, for instance.

For a long time, the first names also played an important role in naming children. Royal names such as John, Peter, and Thomas are chosen from the Bible. Girls' names such as

Faith, Patience, and Sophie (wisdom) are chosen because they symbolize Christian qualities. However, for people who are not necessarily religious but have fond of nature, names like Lily, Benjamin of beauty are often favored. Flower and plant names like Heather, Rosemary, and Ivy are in this category.

Another factor that has had a great effect on the choice of names is the spread of culture through the media. People may choose a name because they are strongly influenced by a character in a book or a television series. They may also adopt names of famous people or their favorite actors and actresses. Sometimes, people pick foreign names for their children because those names are unusual and will thus make their children more distinctive.

Finally, some people just pick a name the sound of which they like, without its meaning, its origins, or its popularity. However, even these people may look at the calendar to pick a lucky day when they make their choice.

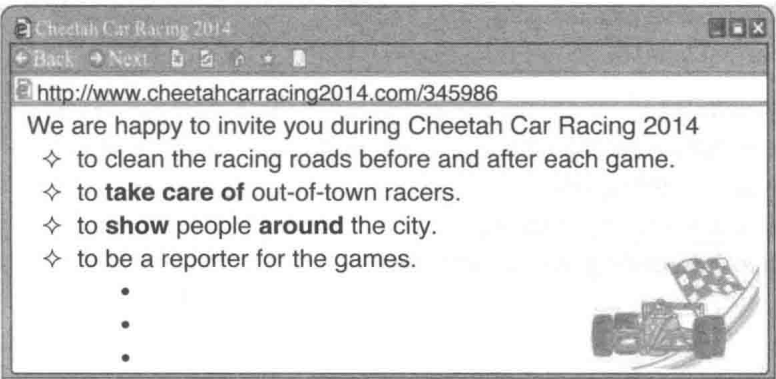
