

Preface 作者序

说到"英文短语",许多人望而怯步的理由不外乎"单词都背不完,我哪有空去学短语?""短语听起来很难,平常应该不会用到吧?""考试会考单词、语法、句型、翻译,很少听到考查短语。"这些理由我也常听到辅导班的学生说,但被我教过的学生最后都会知道,原来这几个理由根本不构成理由!怎么说?就让我借这本书来和大家解释一下吧。

第一个错误观念 单词都背不完,我哪有空去学短语?

确实,大家都很忙,多学一点就多辛苦一点,我完全能理解。可是你知道吗?其实在英语作为母语人士的日常生活中,使用短语的机率很高,有很多短语的意思跟词面上看起来的完全不一样。举个简单的例子: take part in 中的 take 和 in 大家都应该认识,part 是"部分"的意思。可是 take part in 这个短语的意思却是"参加",也就是说就算你知道 take、part 和 in 的意思,你还是一样看不懂这个短语!既然学了单词却不学短语会造成这么多的误解,那就算再没空也得学点短语,不然很多单词对你来说等于白学了!

第二个错误观念 短语听起来很难, 平常应该不会用到吧?

这可不见得! 英文短语并非俚语、谚语、成语,就算是 get up、fall asleep 这种两个连在一起的单词,也一样都是短语哦! 所以绝对会经常用到。而且更奇妙的是,短语虽然词数可能多一点,但有时候反而比单词还更好记、更容易表达意思。举例来说,take part in 有三个单词,感觉好多,可是,如果要用一个单词表示这个意思,那你就得说 participate,看到这个单词那么长,大家应该都会觉得学 take part in 简单些吧。

第三个错误观念 考试会考单词、语法、句型、翻译,很少听到考查短语。

考试真的是会考短语的,这本书就为你验证!当然,考试或许不见得会直接考"请回答这个短语的意思",但是在阅读理解等题型里面,都会出现很多短语!甚至有可能一篇文章有三分之一都是短语!而且有些短语在整个句子中还扮演了关键的角色,也就是说如果看不懂这个短语,就会误解整个句子的意思,然后题目就跟着答错了。要是不懂短语,就算掌握再多单词、语法、句型,还是有可能因为搞不清楚短语意思而白白失分。

大家现在应该跃跃欲试想进入短语的世界了吧?在本书中我对常用常考的短语特别进行了分析,相信对想学短语的你们能有一定程度的帮助。大家一起加油,搞定曾让你望而怯步的短语吧!


