Who's the fairest of them all?



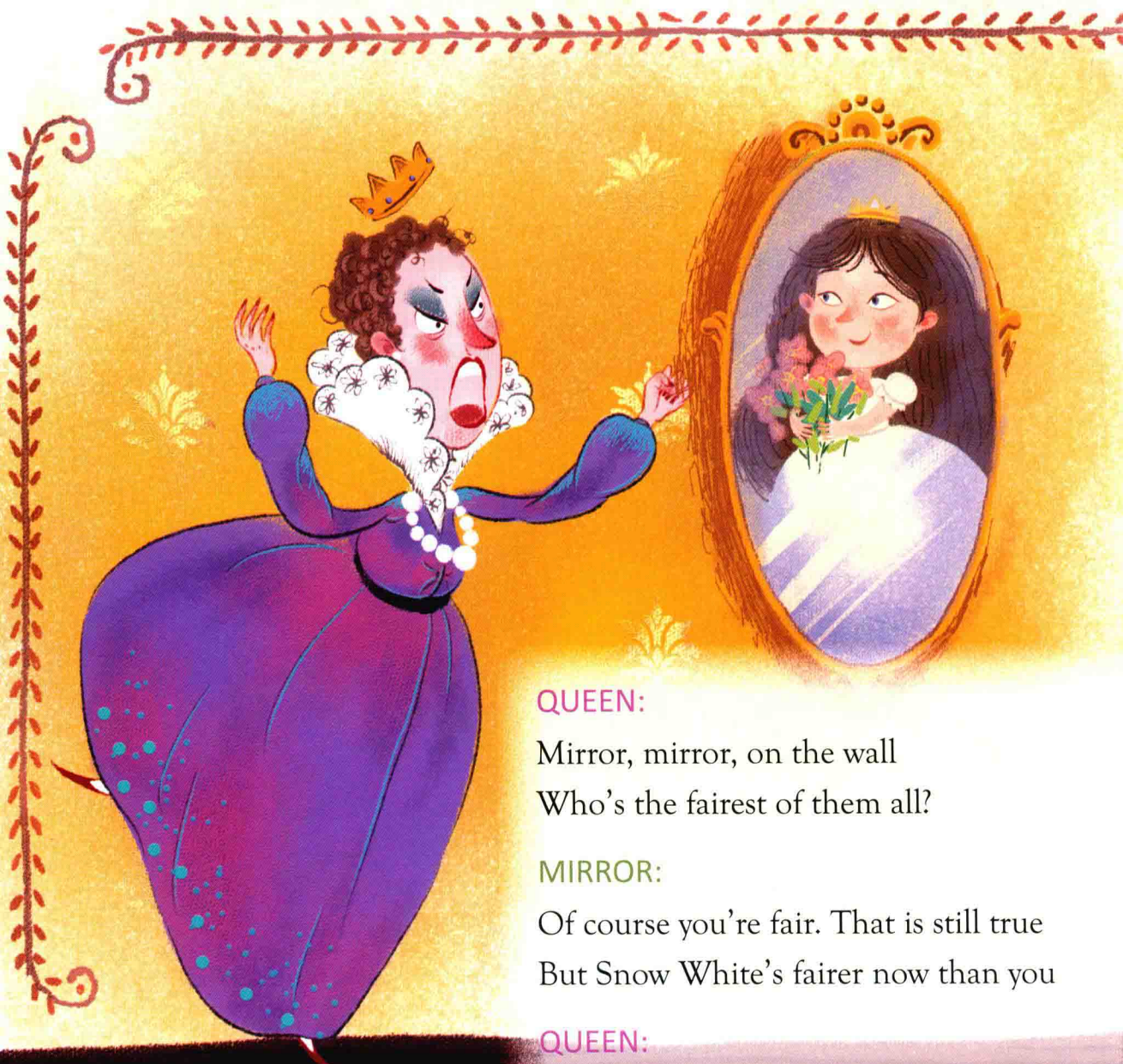
**MIRROR:**

QUEEN:

MIRROR:

Of course you're fair. That is still true  
But Snow White's fairer now than you

QUEEN:

Snow White? Snow White?! How dare you!  
This will never do  
I'm the only beauty here  
There isn't room for two



QUEEN:

Huntsman! To the woods with her!

*The huntsman enters.*

Take Snow White away

Kill her with your hunting knife

I want her dead today

*The huntsman exits.*



**NARRATOR:**

So the huntsman takes Snow White to the woods. He takes out his knife.

*The huntsman and Snow White are in the woods. The huntsman takes out his knife.*



**SNOW WHITE:**

Oh, huntsman, please don't kill me!  
Just leave me in the wood  
I promise that I won't come back  
I'll disappear for good

**HUNTSMAN:**

You've touched my heart, you pretty child  
I'll spare your life today  
I'll tell the queen that you are dead  
Be quick now! Run away!

*Snow White runs off into the woods.*



## Act 2

### NARRATOR:

Snow White runs deep into the woods.

### SNOW WHITE:

It's dark and lonely in the woods  
I'm getting lost, I fear  
If I don't find somebody soon  
I'm going to die out here  
Oh look, I see a little house  
There among the trees  
I'll go and knock upon the door



*She goes to the house, knocks  
on the door and calls out.*

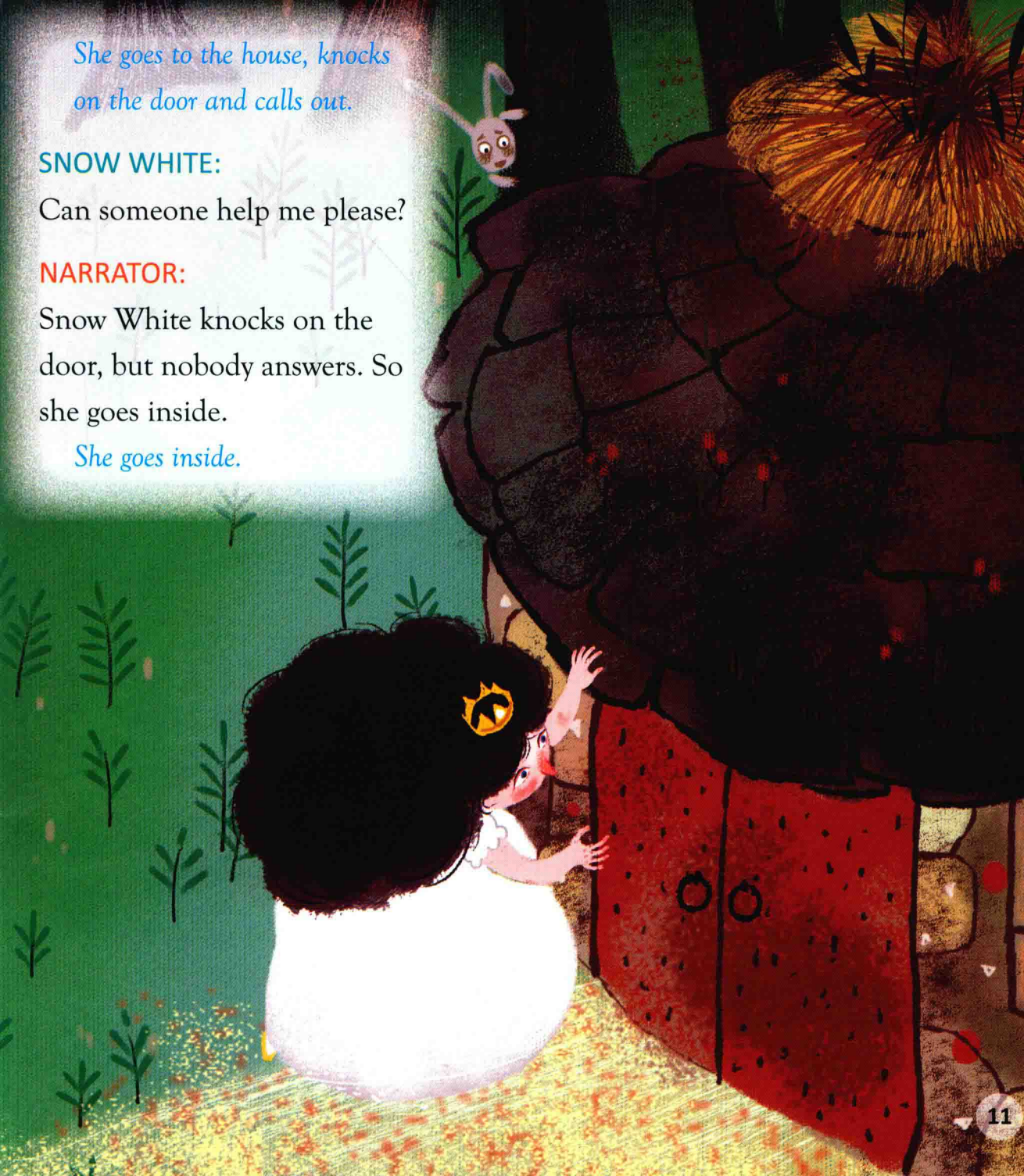
**SNOW WHITE:**

Can someone help me please?

**NARRATOR:**

Snow White knocks on the  
door, but nobody answers. So  
she goes inside.

*She goes inside.*





**SNOW WHITE:** *(to herself)*

What a darling house this is!  
It's really very sweet  
Everything is tiny  
And everything is neat  
Seven plates upon the table  
And seven beds as well  
Seven people live here  
That much I can tell



**NARRATOR:**

Snow White is tired and hungry. She sees some food on the table and she eats.

*Snow White sits at the table and eats.*

**SNOW WHITE:**

Now that I have eaten  
I'd love to rest my head  
I think I'll take a little nap  
Upon this tiny bed

*Snow White lies down and falls asleep.*
