

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### 说 明

本书是人民教育出版社出版的《义务教育课程标准实验教科书英语(新目标)》的系列教材之一。这套教材是在(美国)圣智学习出版公司最新出版的 Go for it! 教材的基础上,由人民教育出版社与圣智学习出版公司合作改编而成的。它采用任务型语言教学(Task-Based Language Teaching)模式,融汇话题、交际功能和语言结构,形成了一套循序渐进的生活化的学习程序。在修改过程中,编者依据国家教育部颁发的《英语课程标准》(实验稿),对原书的结构与内容作了适当的调整,增加了复习单元、文化背景知识和学习策略等部分,并增加了任务型学习成分和语篇输入。本书每个单元都列出明确的语言目标、主要的功能项目与语法结构、需要掌握的基本词汇,并分为A和B两部分。A部分是基本的语言内容,B部分是知识的扩展和综合的语言运用。每个单元还附有 Self Check 部分,学生可用来自我检测本单元所学的语言知识。

本书共14个单元,其中包括2个复习单元,供八年级上学期使用。


