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高等学校英语应用能力考试(Practical English Test for Colleges,简称 PRETCO)是经教育部批准、依据教育部高等教育司《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》(以下简称《基本要求》)而设置的全国统一的标准化考试,旨在检测高等职业教育、普通高等专科教育和成人高等教育的学生是否达到了《基本要求》所规定的实际运用英语的能力。该考试分 A 级和 B 级两种。
