本书是卫生部组织的全国医学博士英语统一考试辅导丛书之一,在结合最新考试大纲和 2010 真题分析的基础上进行了修订。

本书充分考虑了医学考博考生时间紧张、战线长、攻克考试难度强等特点,将医学考博词汇按难易程度和考查范畴分为高中词汇、四级词汇、六级词汇、六级后词汇和医博词汇,便于考生根据自身的英语水平选择合适有效的复习策略。

本书打破了现在很多词汇书主次不清、难易不分、从 A~Z 直接从头到尾排列等编排方式,直接引导考生合理分配备考的时间和精力,考生可以得到更明确的指导,因此本书更具应试性。本书具有以下特点:

1. 科学测试,合理规划复习进度
