本书是上海市前进进修学院 TOEFL 班的指定教材中的《听力部分》，由在该院执教 TOEFL 多年的资深教授编写而成。全书根据近年 TOEFL 已改变的题型要求选编，提供相当数量的 TOEFL 听力模拟试题，综合了历年托福试卷中主要的词汇、语法、句型、背景知识等方面的内容，以帮助 TOEFL 应试人员进一步熟悉题型，提高应试能力。书中附录音文字材料和试题答案供参考，全书配套音带由上海外语音像出版社出版。

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前 言

近年来,随着我国学生英语水平的普遍提高,参加国际性和国内统一英语语言能力考试已成为不少学生检阅自己学习成绩、准备出国深造或加盟国内外商投资企业的一个重要手段。
