2. 在每个周期中, 将每天的单词分成 2~3 个时间段来记忆, 多次少量比少次多量的效果要好。并不断总结构词法, 将构词法知识运用到记单词中。
3. 在每次记忆词汇的过程中, 一定要对不同陌生程度的单词做上不同的标记。在反复记忆的过程中, 一定要反复标记、反复筛选陌生词汇。
4. 每次在记忆新词之前, 一定要浏览前一天已背的词汇。背单词不是简单的重复记忆, 同一个周期中, 应尽可能地充分利用零碎时间, 在不同的场景下反复记忆。
5. 背单词的第一步, 最好是能够大声地朗读出来。同时也可以变换背单词的方式, 如在纸上写、造句、公交车上背、写邮件……随时保持记忆的新鲜感。
6. 记忆新词一定要理解其含义和用法, 认真研读经典例题和例句。每天的单词记忆一定要辅以大量的练习题, 在运用中掌握词汇。
7. 本复习进度表是根据本书的结构特点, 结合相关测试学课题研究 and 多位英语教师自身多年的教学研究编制而成, 供广大读者参考, 不一定完全适用于所有读者。
