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

避免在惯用法和拼写上常犯错误

在口头交际中，你的非文字语言（眼神交流，面部表情，手势，握手，肢体的摆放与移动等）都有助于交流。但是在写作中只有文字才能传达你的思想。因此，正确使用单词和短语对表达你的思想来说至关重要。词语选用得当可以建立起读者和作者间的相互理解；而词和短语使用不当则会导致误解，削弱交流效果。

拼写或读音相似的词常常引起混淆，为避免产生误解就一定要把单词的含义弄准确。

这本书将会帮助你避免人们在惯用法和拼写上常犯的许多错误。

易混词类型 常见易混词有辨义、辨音、辨形三大类型

- ◆ 辨义 **account/bill:** account 和 bill 在意义上非常接近。
- ◆ 辨音 **fair/fare:** fair 和 fare 发音相同，但含义完全不同。
- ◆ 辨形 **adapt/adept/adopt:** 这三个词在字形上非常接近。
