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PREFACE

The Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States Annotated for Statistical Reporting Purposes (HTS) (First Edition, Supplement 2) is being published pursuant to section 1207 of the Omnibus Trade and Competitiveness Act of 1988 (Act) (P.L. 100-418; 19 U.S.C. 3007). ^{1/} Pursuant to section 1217(b) of the Act, the effective date of the HTS is January 1, 1989.

As provided in section 1204(a) of the Act, the legal text of the HTS includes:

- (A) the General Notes;
- (B) the General Rules of Interpretation;
- (C) the Additional U.S. Rules of Interpretation;
- (D) sections I to XXII, inclusive (encompassing chapters 1 to 99, and including all section and chapter notes, article provisions, and tariff and other treatment accorded thereto); and
- (E) the Chemical Appendix to the Harmonized Tariff Schedule;

all conforming to the nomenclature of the Harmonized System Convention.

The HTS also includes the statistical annotations, notes, annexes, suffixes, check digits, units of quantity, and other matters formulated under section 484(e) of the Tariff Act of 1930, and the table of contents, footnotes, index, and other matters inserted for ease of reference.

The principal changes in Supplement 2 to the First Edition of the HTS (USITC Publication 2030) are the modifications reflected in Presidential Proclamation 5885 of October 20, 1988 (53 FR 41551) (imposing increased duties on certain imported articles that are the products of Brazil), Presidential Proclamation ____ (modifying the HTS pursuant to section 1204(b) of the Act (the implementing

^{1/} Section 1207(a) of the Act provides that "[t]he Commission shall compile and publish, at appropriate intervals, and keep up to date the Harmonized Tariff Schedule and related information in the form of printed copy...". Section 1207(b) of the Act provides that the published copy of the HTS "shall contain--(1) the then current Harmonized Tariff Schedule; (2) statistical annotations and related statistical information formulated under section 484(e) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1484(e)); and (3) such other matters as the Commission considers to be necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes enumerated in the Preamble to the [Harmonized System] Convention."

Proclamation)) and the changes approved by the Committee for Statistical Annotation of Tariff Schedules (484(e) Committee).

The implementing Proclamation, issued pursuant to section 1204(b) of the Act, contains such modifications to the HTS as are necessary or appropriate to implement: (1) future outstanding staged U.S. tariff rate reductions; and (2) the applicable provisions of statutes enacted, executive actions taken and final judicial decisions rendered after January 1, 1988, and before January 1, 1989, as well as certain necessary technical rectifications. The principal changes in the implementing Proclamation reflect:

- (1) Subtitle G, part 1 of title I of the Omnibus Trade and Competitiveness Act of 1988 (P.L. 100-418; 102 Stat. 110) (making both permanent and temporary changes in U.S. tariff treatment);
- (2) Presidential Proclamation 4707 of December 11, 1979 (44 FR 72348) (staged rate reductions agreed to by the United States in the Tokyo Round of trade negotiations);
- (3) Presidential Proclamation 4768 of June 28, 1980 (45 FR 45135) (staged duty reductions agreed to by the United States pursuant to the agreement on the implementation of Article VII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (the Customs Valuation Code));
- (4) Presidential Proclamation 5365 of August 30, 1985 (50 FR 36220) (staged rate reductions agreed to by the United States pursuant to the United States - Israel Free Trade Area Agreement);
- (5) Presidential Proclamation 5779 of March 23, 1988 (53 FR 9850) (amending the Generalized System of Preferences);
- (6) Presidential Proclamation 5787 of March 31, 1988 (53 FR 11031) (amending the Generalized System of Preferences);
- (7) Presidential Proclamation 5805 of April 29, 1988 (53 FR 15785) (amending the Generalized System of Preferences);
- (8) Presidential Proclamation 5832 of June 16, 1988 (53 FR 23199) (amending the quantitative limitations on imports of certain cheese);
- (9) Presidential Proclamation 5836 of June 28, 1988 (53 FR 24921) (withdrawing nondiscriminatory treatment for products of Romania);
- (10) Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR) notice of April 21, 1988 (53 FR 13207) (adjusting quotas on imports of tungsten from China);
- (11) USTR notice of July 20, 1988 (53 FR 27446) (implementing amendments to the specialty steel import relief program);
- (12) Department of Agriculture notice of July 27, 1988 (53 FR 28241) (amending the import quotas on sugar for the 1988 quota period);
- (13) numerous technical rectifications, including modifications resulting from editorial changes in the text of the Annex to the International Convention on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System agreed to by the Customs Cooperation Council.

The HTS has been annotated to include such matters as may be necessary for reporting statistics formulated pursuant to section 484(e), Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1484(e)). 1/ The statistical annotations contained in the HTS prescribe the statistical information to be supplied on customs entry and withdrawal forms with respect to articles imported into the customs territory of the United States. Thus, this publication is designed to enable importers, customs brokers, customs officers and other interested persons to determine (1) the classifications and rates of duty applicable to imported articles and (2) the requirements for reporting statistical data with respect to such imports. This publication may also be used in place of the reporting codes of Schedule B for reporting exports on the Shipper's Export Declaration or under the program for electronic reporting of exports.

Requests from interested parties for changes in any of the requirements for statistical reporting should be submitted no later than August 1 to:

Such requests should precisely indicate the nature of each desired change and give detailed reasons in support of the request.

1/ Sec. 484(e), as amended, reads as follows:

"(e) Statistical Enumeration.--The Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of Commerce, and the United States International Trade Commission are authorized and directed to establish from time to time for statistical purposes an enumeration of articles in such detail as in their judgment may be necessary, comprehending all merchandise imported into the United States and exported from the United States, and shall seek, in conjunction with statistical programs for domestic production and programs for achieving international harmonization of trade statistics, to establish the comparability thereof with such enumeration of articles. All import entries and export declarations shall include or have attached thereto an accurate statement specifying, in terms of such detailed enumeration, the kinds and quantities of all merchandise imported and exported and the value of the total quantity of each kind of article."

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
