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出 版 说 明

物业管理业在我国被誉为"朝阳行业",方兴未支,发展迅猛。行业中的管理理念、管理方法、管理规范、管理条例、管理技术随着社会经济的发展不断更新。另一方面,近年来我国中等职业教育的教育环境正在发生深刻的变化。客观上要求有符合目前行业发展变化情况、应用性强、有鲜明职业教育特色的专业教材与之相适应。

受建设部委托,第三、第四届建筑与房地产经济专业指导委员会在深入调研的基础上,对中职学校物业管理专业教育标准和培养方案进行了整体改革,系统提出了中职教育物业管理专业的课程体系,进行了课程大纲的审定,组织编写了本系列教材。

本系列教材以目前我国经济较发达地区的物业管理模式为基础,以目前物业管理的最新条例、最新规范、最新技术为依据,以努力贴近行业实际,突出教学内容的应用性、实践性和针对性为原则进行编写。本系列教材既可作为中职学校物业管理专业的教材,也可供物业管理基层管理人员自学使用。

前言

随着改革开放的不断深入,房地产行业蓬勃发展,物业管理也成为一个新兴行业。在物业管理中,英语作为一种国际通用的语言,逐渐成为工作中必不可少的工具。在中等职业学校中开设物业管理专业英语课程适应了发展的需要。本书就是为全国中等职业学校物业管理专业的专业英语教学编写的教材。

由于全国各地物业管理水平发展的不平衡,英语在工作中的需求的不平衡,各地义务教育中英语教学课程标准的不平衡,使得各地中等职业学校专业英语教学的基础差距很大,譬如各省市中职校英语课程标准中词汇量要求(能查到的)差别竟接近一倍。这就使得编写一本要适用于全国各地中等职业学校物业管理专业的专业英语教材难度不小。根据全国中等职业学校物业管理英语课程教学大纲要求,全书编为12个单元加一个加强模块。每个单元包括两篇课文和两篇对话,以及配合的习题。第一篇课文较浅,第二篇略深,主要是通过学习,了解和掌握一些物业管理的英语表达语句和专业术语。每篇课文后都配备注解、帮助理解课文的问题以及生词和短语表。授课教师可以根据不同情况选用。限于教学课时,考虑专业情景需要,设计了基本的对话。习题设计主要是通过练习,加强对课文的理解、词汇的掌握以及对话的操练。对于英语语法,不作过高要求,只要能够理解即可。习题的参考答案没有编入,准备另外编写,以便教师参考。如果学生基础较好,完成12个单元后尚有时间,则可学习加强模块,加强模块可以集中教授,也可按大纲安排,分散讲授,让学生了解一些英语简单写作的知识。为方便复习,总词汇表列于最后。课文和对话中的房地产英语基本术语已按中华人民共和国建设部 2003 年 3 月 17 日批准的《房地产业基本术语标准》校准。

为了增加英语学习的兴趣,每个单元前还安排一条"语言的盐"——谚语。本书虽为全国中等职业学校物业管理专业的专业英语教学而编写,也可以作为物业管理行业专业英语培训教材。

囿于时间和水平,本书肯定存在许多不足之处。望各位同行指正。如有各种宝贵的意见、建议和要求,恳请直接告诉我们,以利修正。

Text A Property Management

Property is all the things, usually land or buildings, belonging to someone. In real estate industry, it means all the houses in use. Owners of the houses contract the management of the real property to a specialized company. It is generally called property management company.

In western countries, a property management company is also a real estate company. But in China, it is different from the real estate company which usually deals with the buying and selling of houses. Its task is to operate and maintain the buildings and equipments, and to safeguard the housing estate.

Professional property management is a completely new industry in China. Managing a large piece of commercial or residential area where hundreds of thousands of people live or work is a very difficult task. Therefore, it is very important for us to learn practical knowledge and skills about property management.

Text B The Contents of Property Management

Most real estate development companies used to emphasize the profits of their investment. They often care about the good location, the designs of the houses, the cost of construction, and reasonable long-term financing. Today more and more people come to realize the importance of day-to-day operation of the property after the completion of the investment project.

In the past, most real estate was state-owned. Housing estates were in control of the government with very limited service. This kind of management has changed greatly with more and more houses becoming non-state-owned in recent years.

The duty of property management includes cleaning, security, charge collection, maintenance and repairs. In one word, to keep the property in normal use and make the environment better for the people living or working in, property management companies must be set up to provide many kinds of services to the owners or tenants directly or indirectly.

Unit 2

Text A Business Categories

A property management company may deal with the management of housing estates, high-rise buildings, complex buildings, office and commercial buildings as well as hotels, factories and warehouses. The business includes renting, maintaining, cleaning, securing, parking, and so on. These services aim to provide the residents with comfortable living and working environment.

More specifically, the business of a property management company may be classified into following four categories: 1) general business, including maintenance of houses and piecemeal repair for public facilities; 2) particular business, including security, cleaning, gardening and parking; 3) special services entrusted by residents, for example, delivering newspapers or booking air tickets, etc; 4) other business like inside finishing and repairing, house exchange, leasing and renting, etc. The later two items are charged additionally.

Text B Tasks

Property management involves a wide variety of tasks and these tasks can be handled in three different ways:

- 1. A company that deals exclusively in property management. This type of company will usually be headed by one or more certified property managers, who have been trained to get a diploma and manage property for others.
- 2. A real estate brokerage firm with a department set up to manage property. In this case, property management is only part of the firm's total business.
- 3. A property manager who takes charge of a specific building. Many apartment and office buildings have a property manager's office. If the management of one property is not a full-time job, the person may also manage other buildings.

However, property management is a complex field that demands a professional approach. Property management is a rewarding profession because it allows you to use a diverse range of abilities and skills. It can lead to a new career.

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
