本书难度、深度适中,主要对象为对英语学习有极强要求和兴趣、又有紧迫感和压力感的大学本科生、高职高专生及具有相应水平的英语学习者,其适用范围较广。

前 言

在中国长期的英语教学中,无论是在中学,还是在大学,我们一直非常重视语法知识的讲授,所以我国学生不乏对一般语法知识的理论了解。而大部分语法书籍或者面面俱到、繁冗拖沓,或者简要描述、重点归纳,却都缺乏相应的形式多样的语法练习。所以尽管许多学生从中学到大学,近十年寒窗努力,却仍没有打下扎实的语法基本功。为了帮助考生尽快摆脱困境,牢固掌握语法知识,并能对其运用自如,我们编写了本书。

本书具有以下特点:

1. 紧扣教学要求,精选大量练习。

本书根据中学及大学英语教学要求,密切结合中学及大学英语教学语法重点和难点,从多层次多方面精选大量练习,强调熟能生巧。

2. 练习形式多样,要点难点突出。

本书分章节简要归纳语法知识要点和考试难点,针对各语法要点给出形式多样的练习题,从多个角度就语法进行练习和巩固。以非谓语动词为例,通过用非谓语动词的适当形式填空、用不定式、-ED 分词和-ING 分词替换下列划线部分、用非谓语动词完成下列句子、改正下列句中的错误、多项选择等练习,对与非谓语动词有关的语法现象进行操练,使读者熟练掌握。

3. 练习系统全面,培养运用能力。

本书从词法、句法出发,语法知识包涵全面。从局部到整体,

从侧面到全面,组成一个完整的体系,且大部分练习需读者用笔、动脑完成,培养读者语言运用能力,现学现用,立竿见影。

4. 难度深度适中,适用范围广泛。

本书难度、深度适中,主要对象为对英语学习有极强要求和兴趣、又有紧迫感和压力感的中学生、高职高专生、大学本科生及具有相应水平的英语学习者,其运用范围较广,可作为读者巩固掌握语法知识的配套练习及各类英语应考练习用书。

知识要点:

1. 掌握词汇中的名词, 名词的性、数、格以及名词词组修饰语。
2. 名词分类可以从不同的角度进行; 可以根据构词法分类; 可以根据词汇意义分类; 也可以根据语法意义分类等。

考试难点:

1. 避免名词与形容词的误用;
2. 避免名词之间的误用;
例如: heart, mind, brain, head 之间的区别
3. 避免名词单复数的误用;
例如: stimulus 和 stimuli; phenomenon 和 phenomena
4. 注意某些名词特殊单复数;
例如: leaf —— leaves; bacterium —— bacteria
5. 避免名词与动名词的误用;
6. 掌握名词做定语与复合名词;
7. 名词词组的固定搭配, 其结构形式可以表示为:
(限定词) + (前置修饰语) + 名词 + (后置修饰语)
例如: *All the college students should make the most of their time on campus.*
