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前 言

听力是英语教学中四项基本技能之一,也是大学生面临的一个难点。突破这一难点犹如牵一发而动全身,必将有助于其他单项技能的训练,同时也为培养学生交际能力奠定了一个良好的基础。众所周知,要提高听力,不是一朝一夕就能达到的。学生需要经过长期、大量、反复的操练。同时,听力材料的选用也异常关键。《活力英语听力教程——Let's Listen》就是按照大学英语教学大纲的要求,根据我国大学生听力水平及英语教学特点而编写的一本听力教材。编写该书的目的在于指导学生进行系统的培训,帮助学生循序渐进地提高听力水平;同时也为学生参加大学英语三、四、六级考试及其他相关考试提供实战训练。

本书内容丰富,题材广泛,材料新颖,信息量大,涉及各种情景对话,所选文章包括政治、经济、文化、科技、历史、地理、体育等各类题材。难度由浅入深,编排合理。

本书针对性强,适合各类大专院校的学生学习,尤其适用于参加大学英语三、四、六级考试及其他相关考试的学生。对英语爱好者而言,它也是一本难得的课外听力自学训练材料。

本书共分30个单元。每个单元由三部分组成,分别是听写填空、对话和短文,每一单元都列出了相应生词、短语及习惯搭配,便于学习者使用。书后还附有原文材料和参考答案,并配有录音磁带。磁带由具有多年教学经验的外籍专家朗读,语音标准,语调纯正、地道。

总之,本书针对学生听力普遍较差这一特点,集中了大量翔实、

丰富的材料,是一本实用性很强的听力训练材料。它对于提高学生 听力水平和应试能力都会有很大帮助。本书也可作为英语教师的 参考资料。

本书由西南财经大学语言文化学院长期从事大学英语教学工作、具有丰富听力教学经验的教师编写。当然,由于编写时间有限及各种因素的制约,书中不免存在不足之处,敬请读者及各位同行指正。
