G g H h I i J j K k L l M m

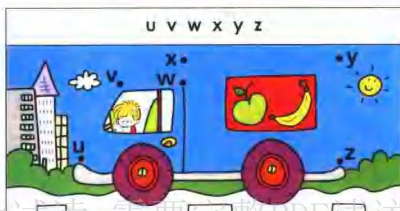
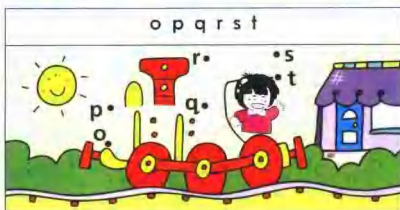
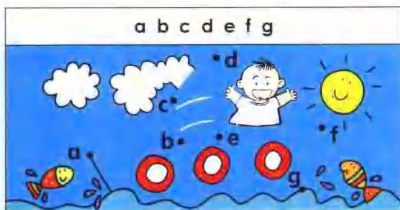
